I've had three or four Optometry students as tenants over the last couple years in my beautiful shared home in the North Bethesda area near Walter Reed Military Hospital. Each of these students "found" me through Craigslist which is a great advertising medium, but comes with it's own set of trust and relationship problems.

I am a retired Naval Officer and Dr. Girdher is my Optometrist at Walter Reed, she has all my information. The house I have available is set up as a share, rented to four individuals, each with their separate bedroom, sharing the common areas. All utilities are included, including cable, internet and WiFi. Rentals start at \$950 per month. Current tenants include a retired school teacher who grew up in Garret Park, she is long term and provides a wealth of local area knowledge; a medical student on rotation at Walter Reed; and two optometry students.
