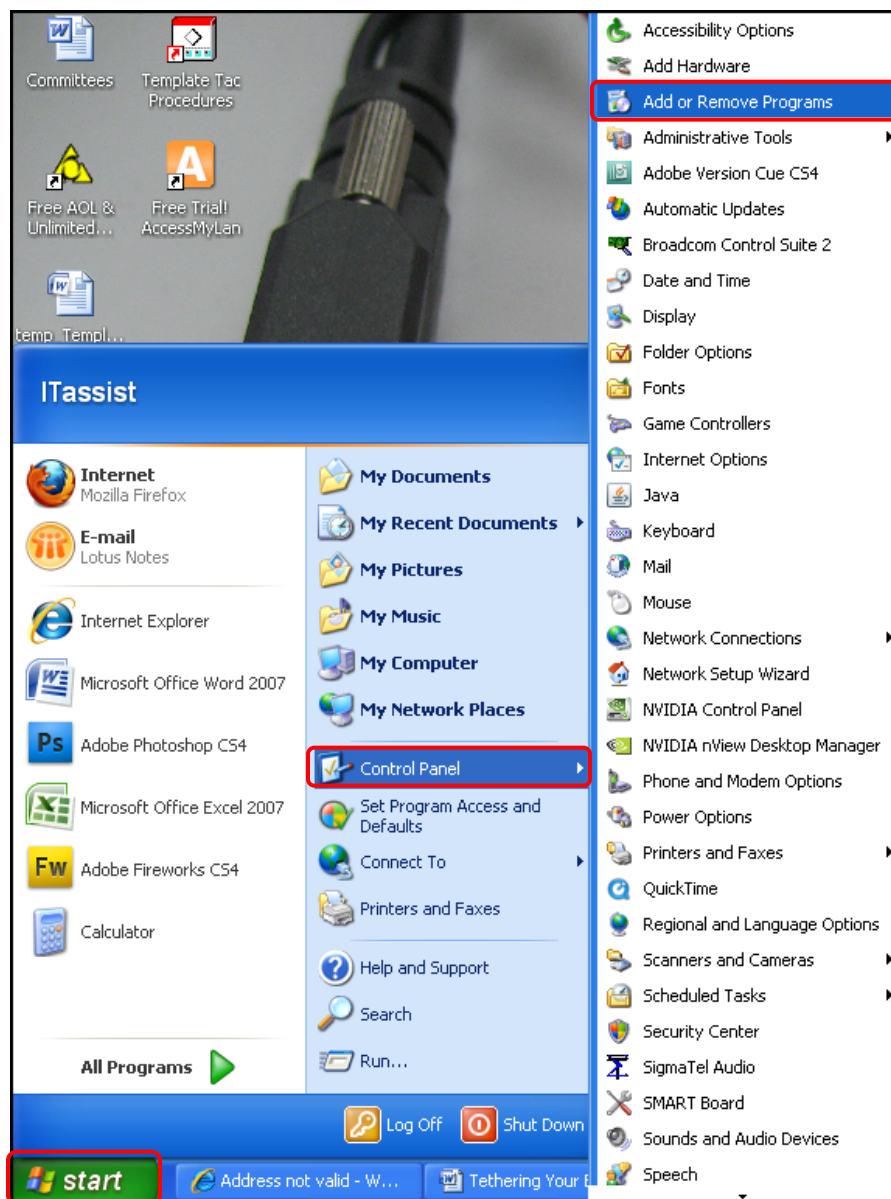


Tethering Your BlackBerry Device

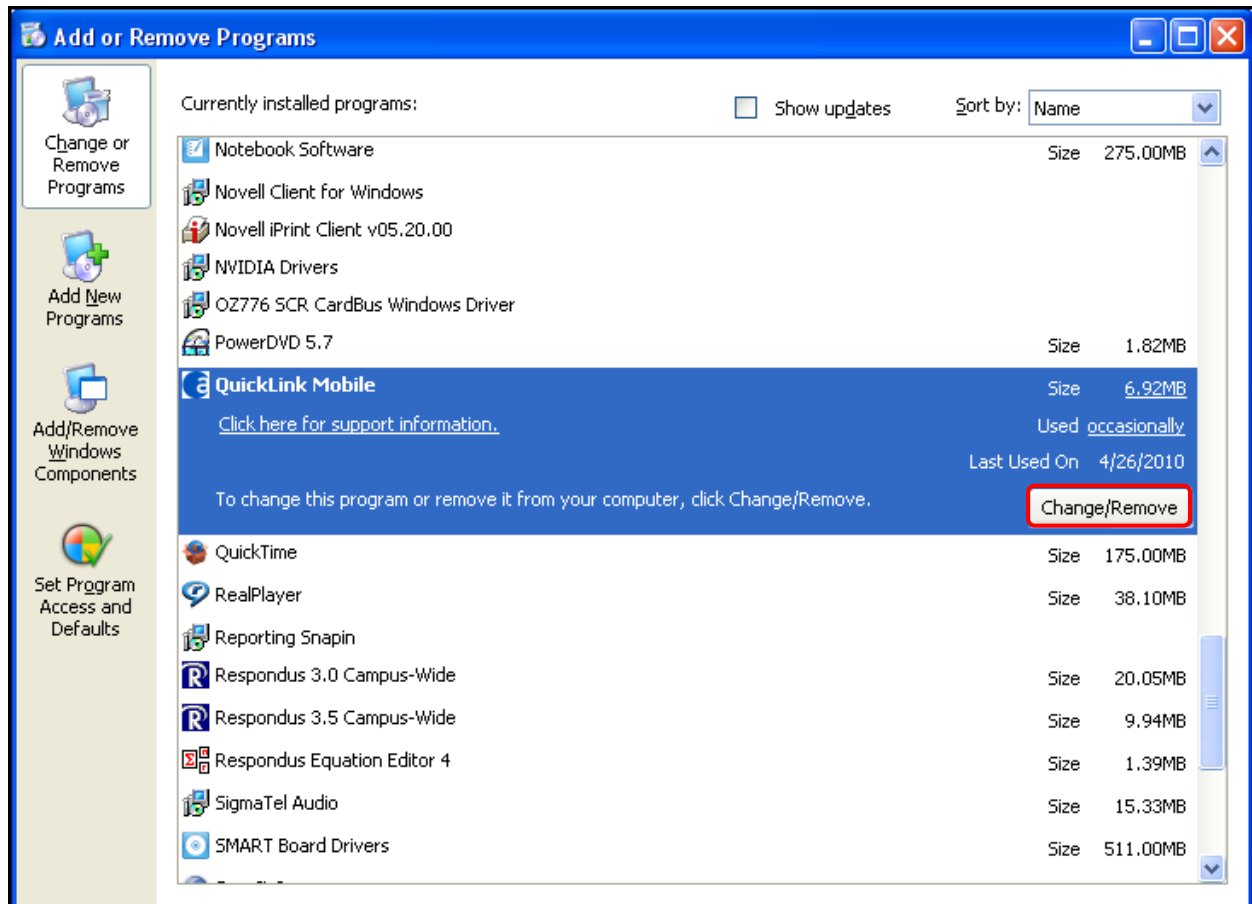
Because of the recent switch from Alltel to Verizon, you will need to uninstall Alltel QuickLink Mobile (if you still have it installed on your computer). After uninstalling this program, you will need to download VZAccess Manager from the website. These steps need to be taken in order to tether your BlackBerry device.

Removing Alltel QuickLink Mobile

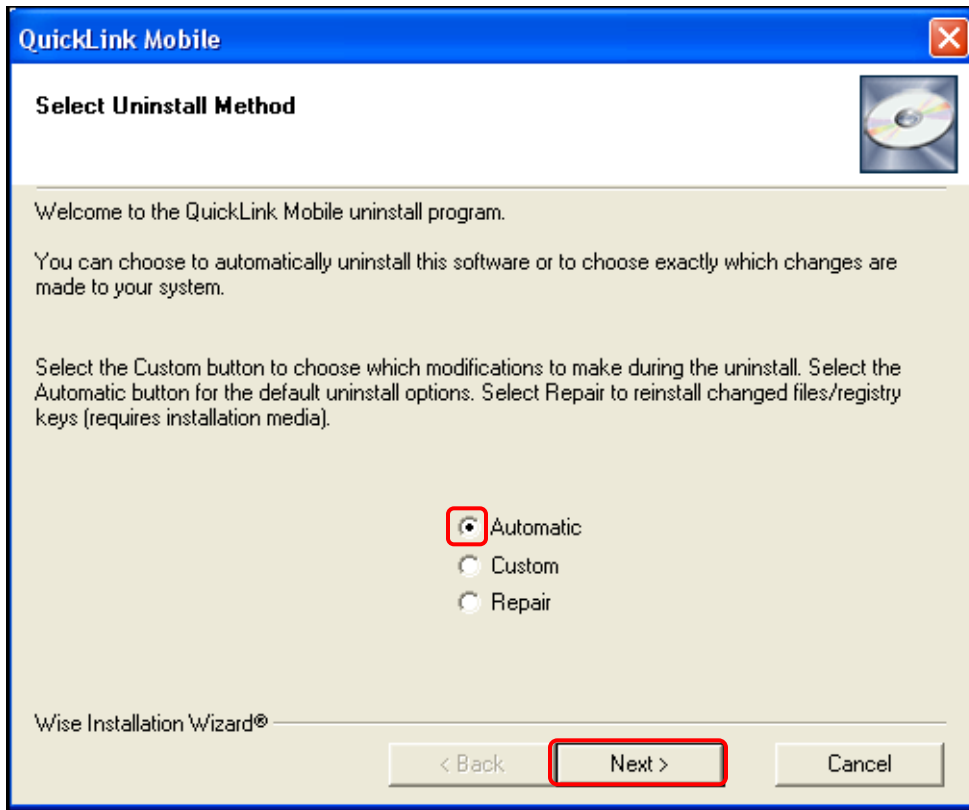
1. Click **Start**.
2. Select **Control Panel** then click **Add or Remove Programs**.



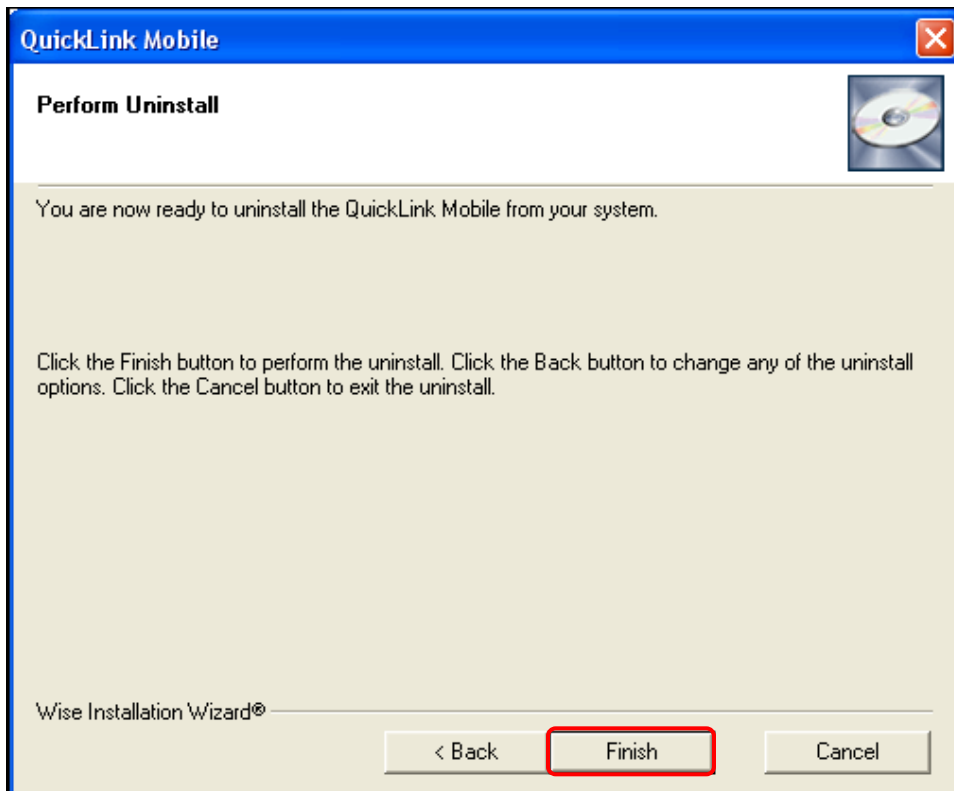
3. In the Add or Remove Programs dialog box, scroll down and locate **QuickLink Mobile**. Select it and click **Change/Remove**.



4. In the QuickLink Mobile dialog box, keep **Automatic** selected and click **Next**.



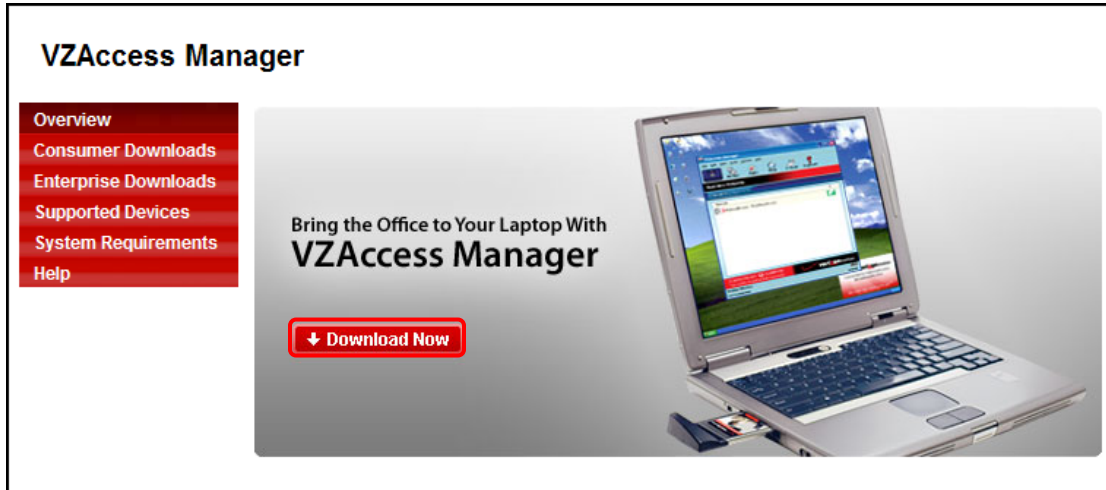
5. In the resulting dialog box, click **Finish**.



6. Completely shut your computer down and restart before downloading VZAccess Manager.

Downloading VZAccess Manager

1. Go to <http://www.vzam.net> and download the VZAccess Manager by clicking **Download Now**.



2. Scroll down to PDA/Advanced Device and locate the BlackBerry section.

3. Click on the link that applies to your current operating system.

5. Click **Continue**.

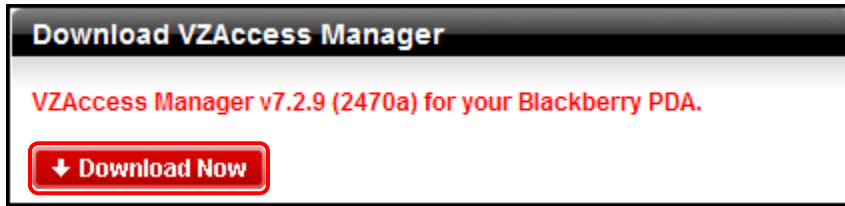

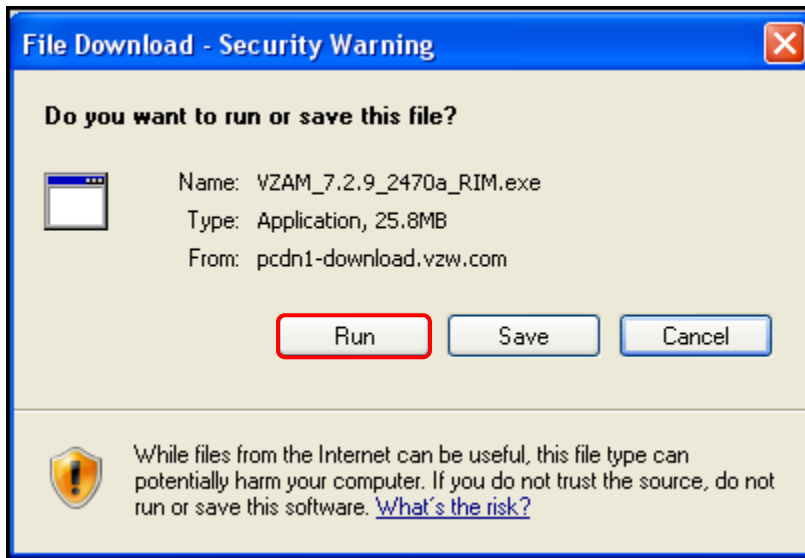

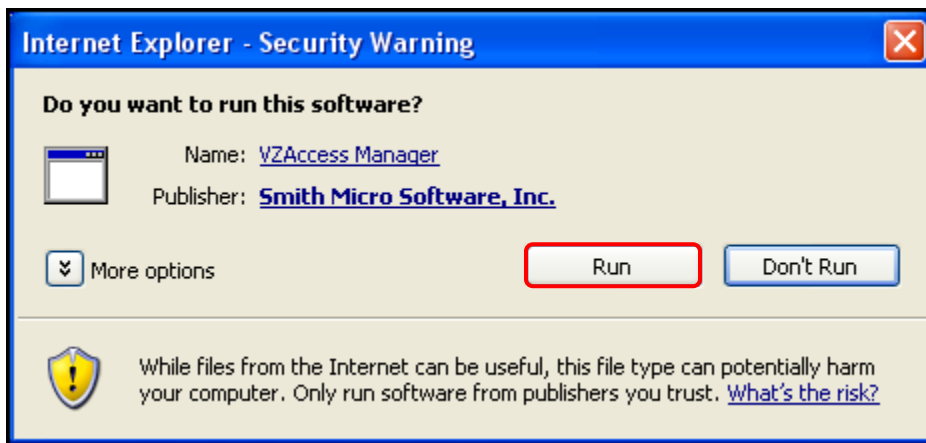
6. Click **Download Now**.



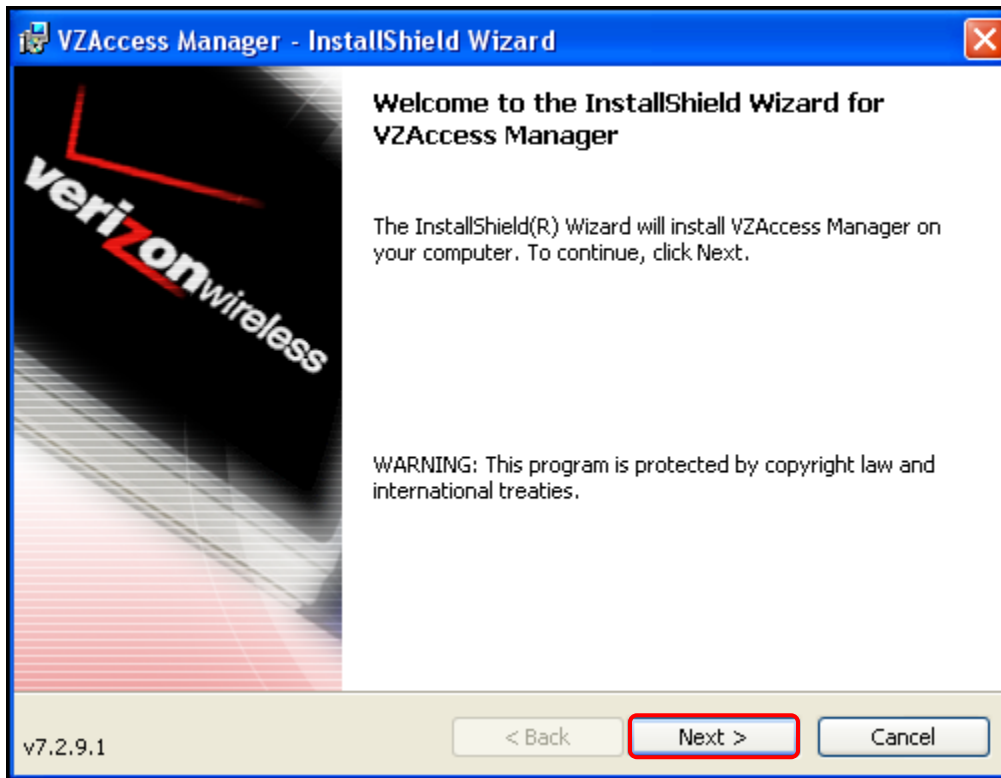
7. In the File Download – Security Warning box, click **Run**.



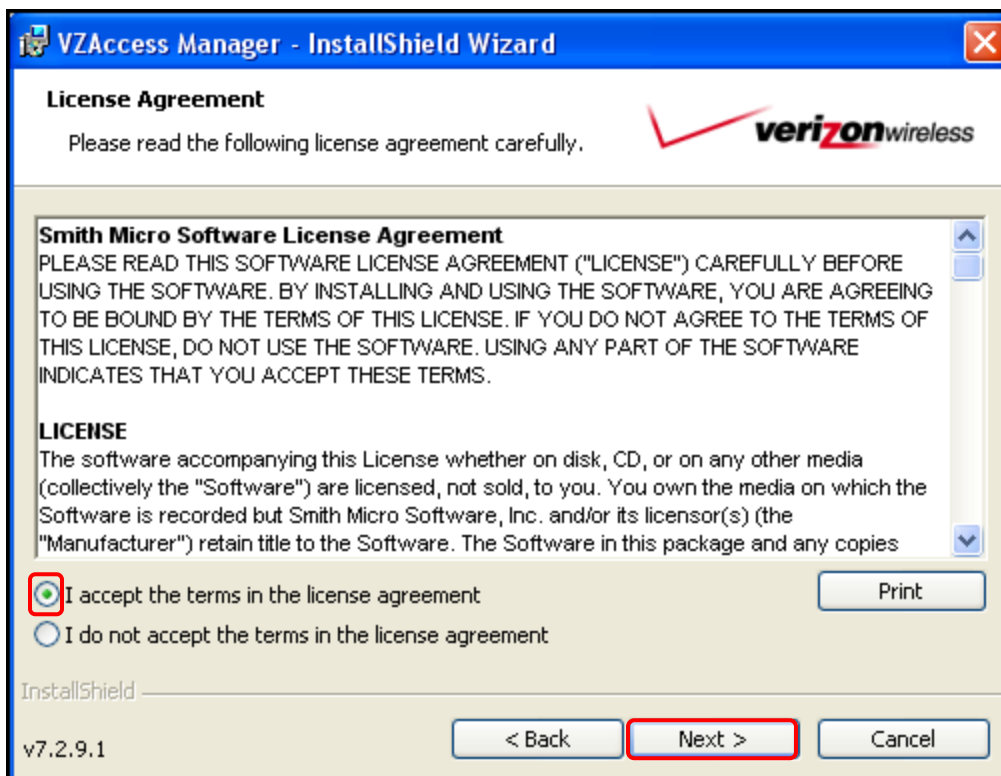
8. After the download, another Security Warning dialog box will appear. Click **Run** again.



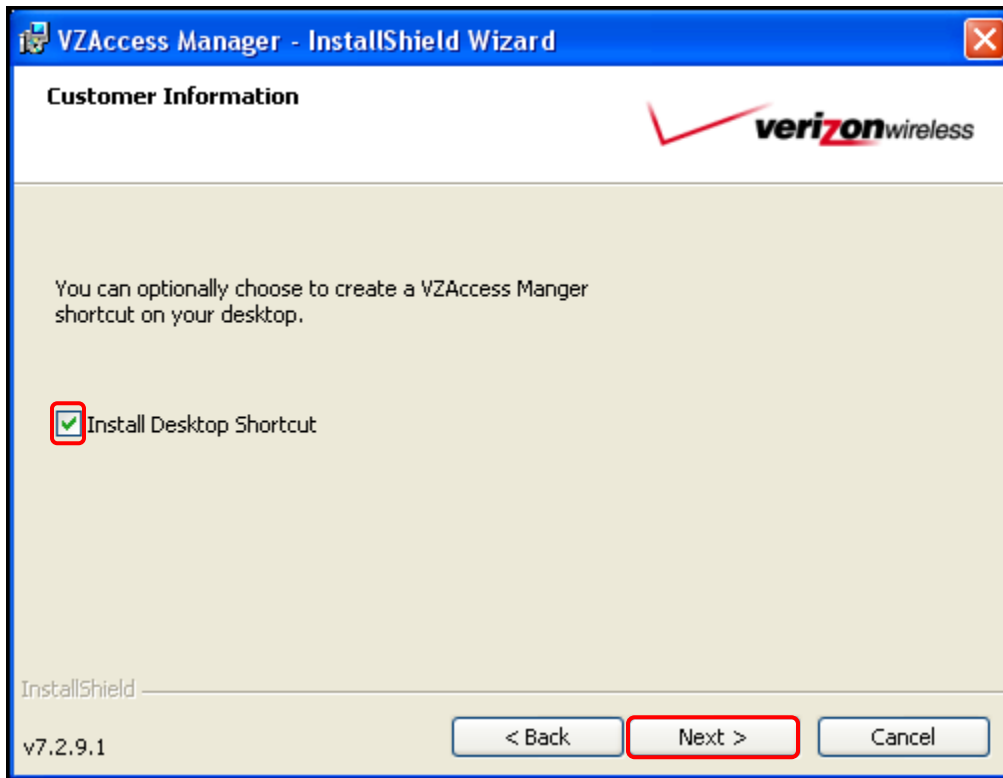
9. A VZAccess Manager – InstallShield Wizard dialog box will appear. Click **Next**.



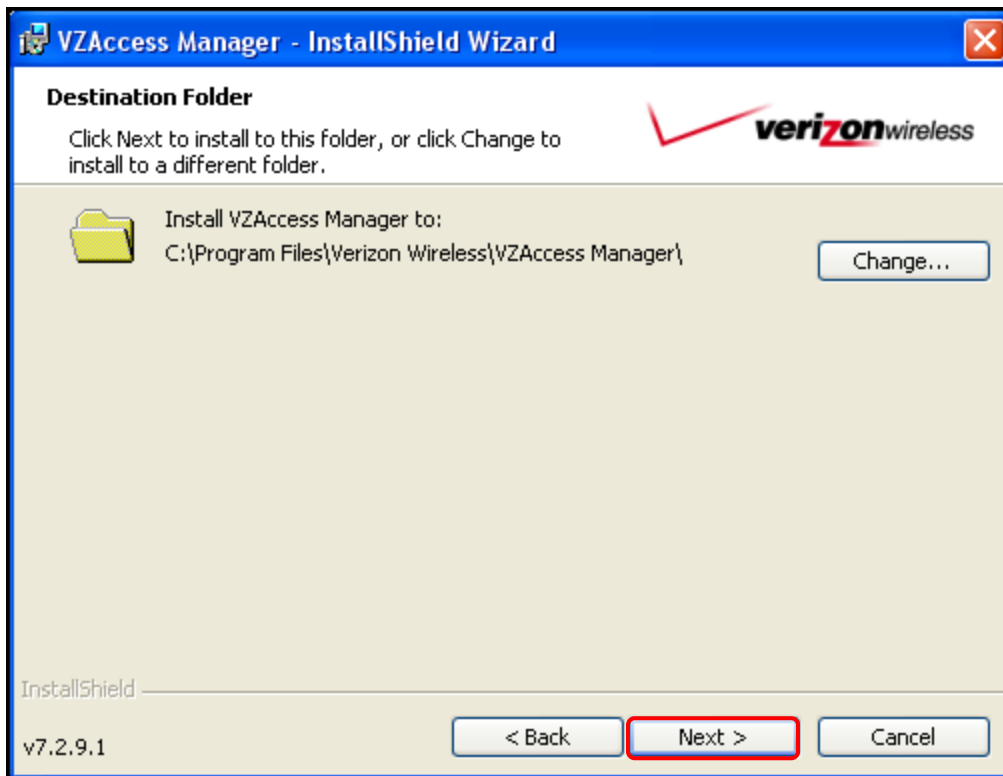
10. Select the button for **I accept the terms in the license agreement** and click **Next**.



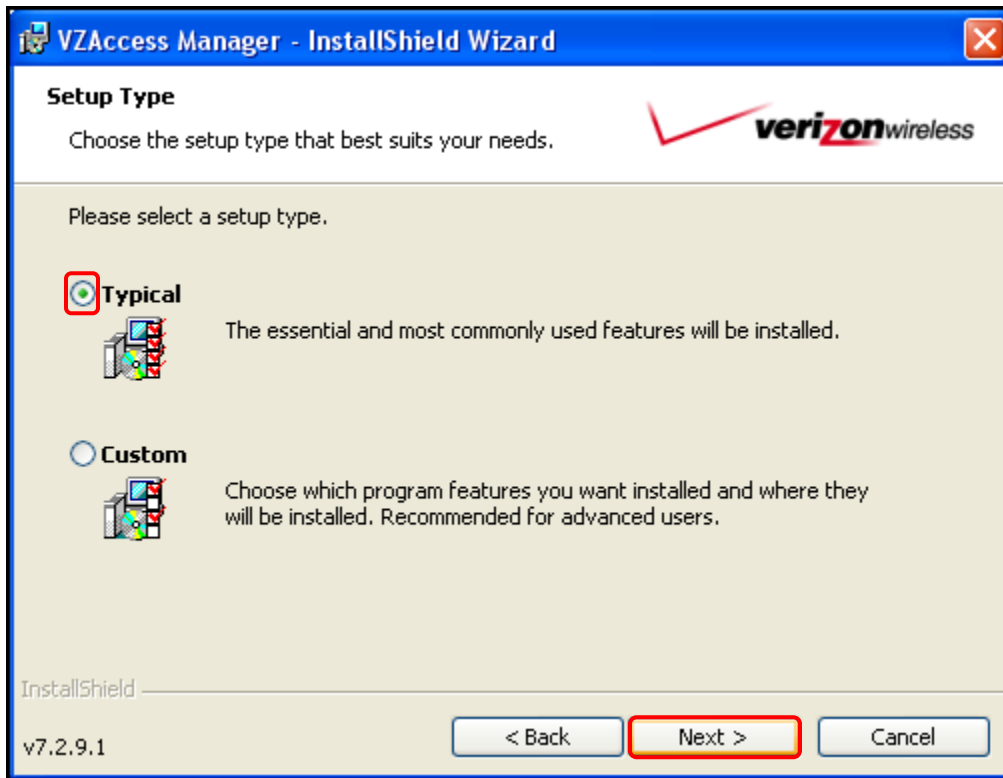
11. Select whether you would like to install a desktop shortcut and click **Next**.



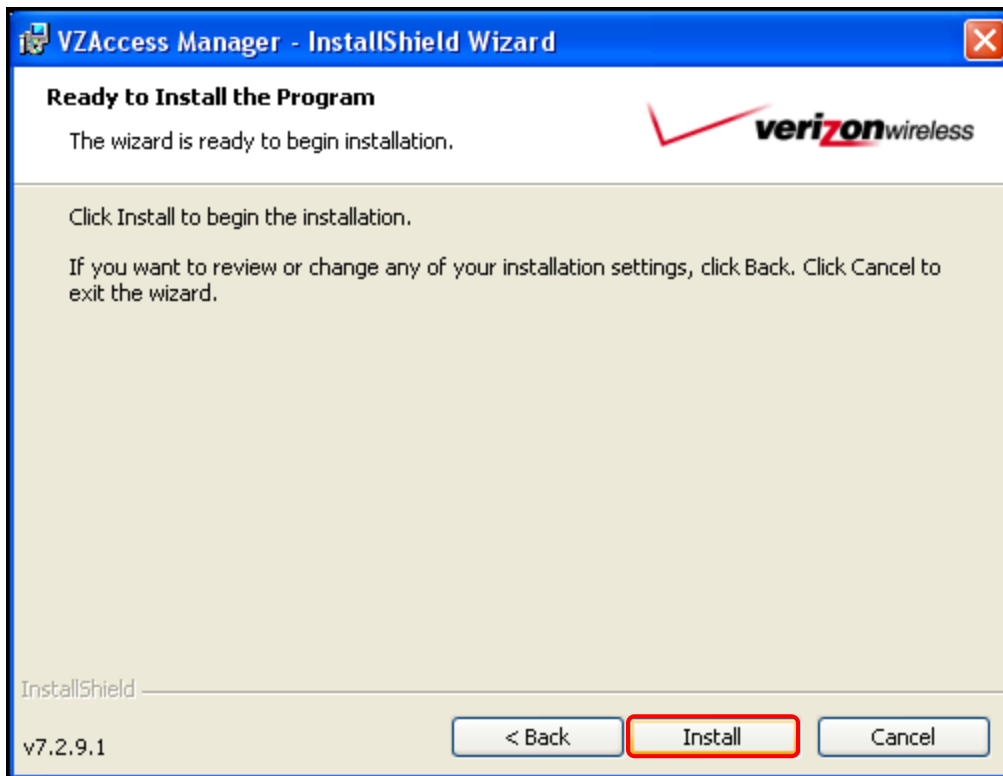
12. Click **Next** again.



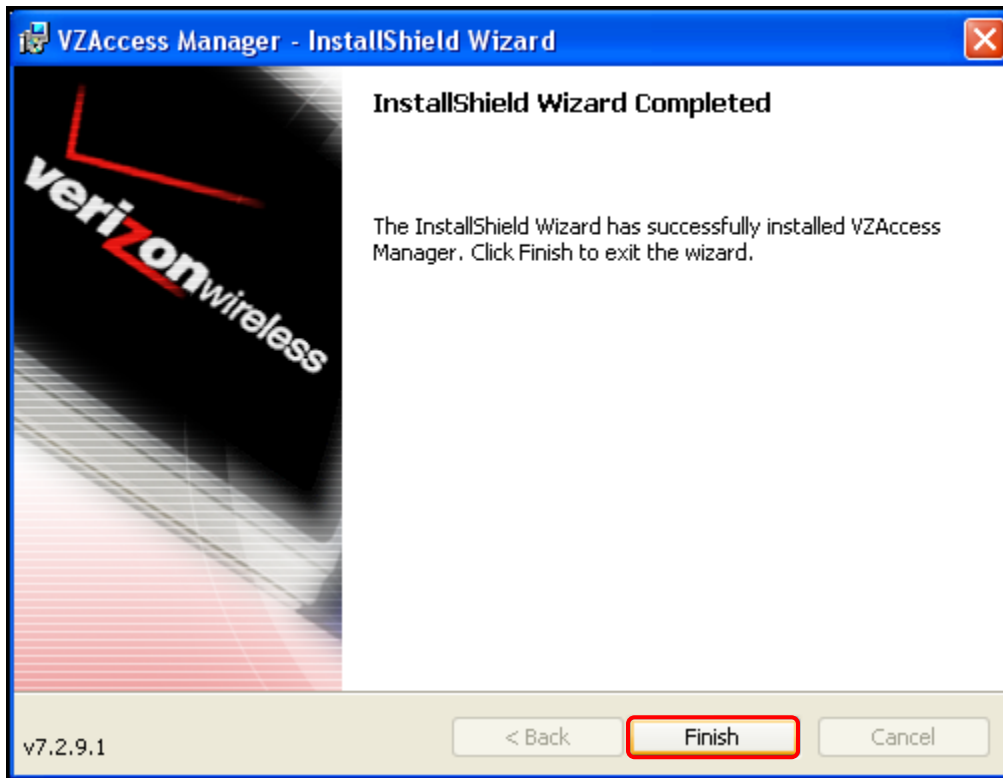
13. Make sure **Typical** is selected and click **Next**.



14. Click **Install**.



15. Click **Finish**.

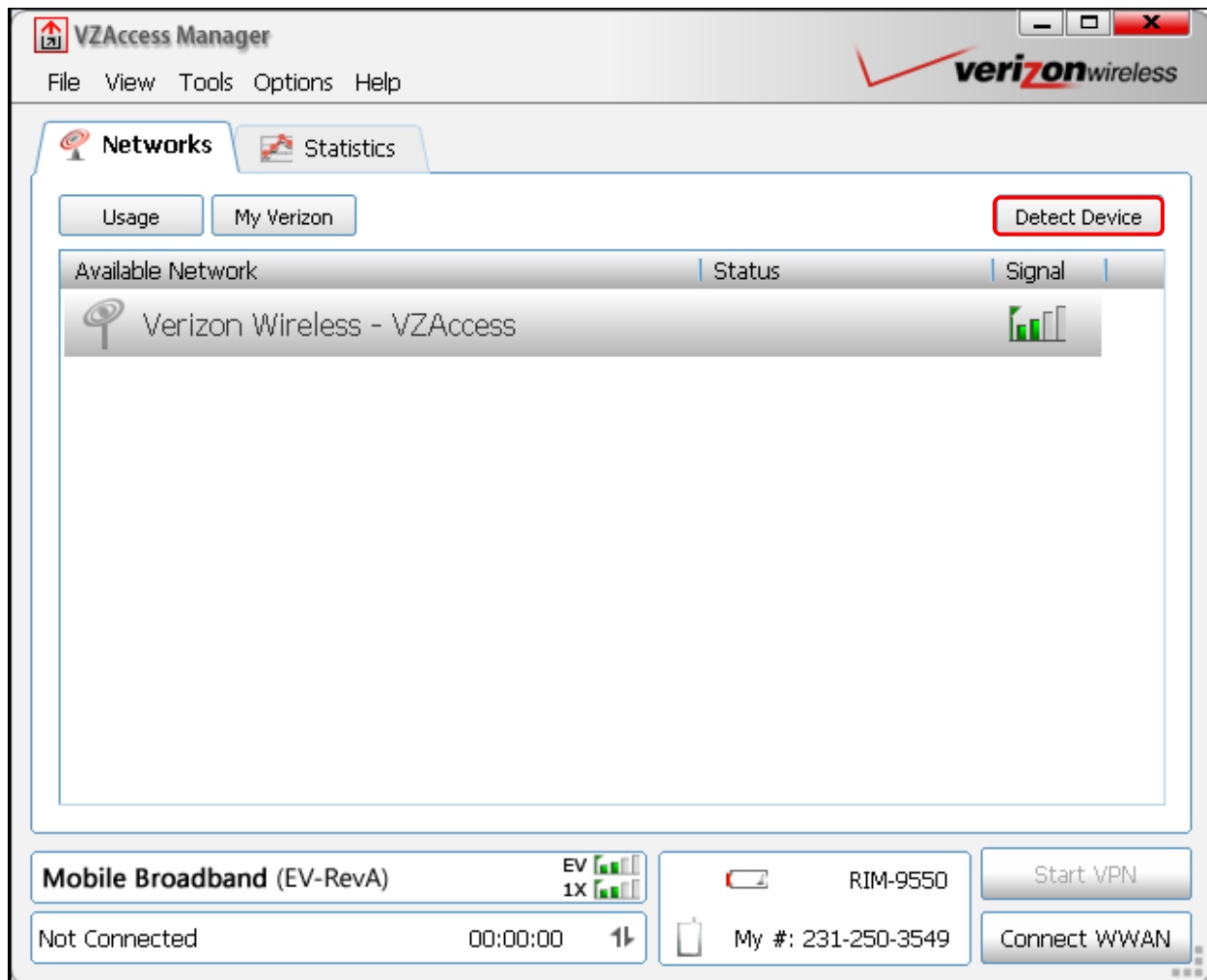


Tethering Your BlackBerry Using VZAccess Manager

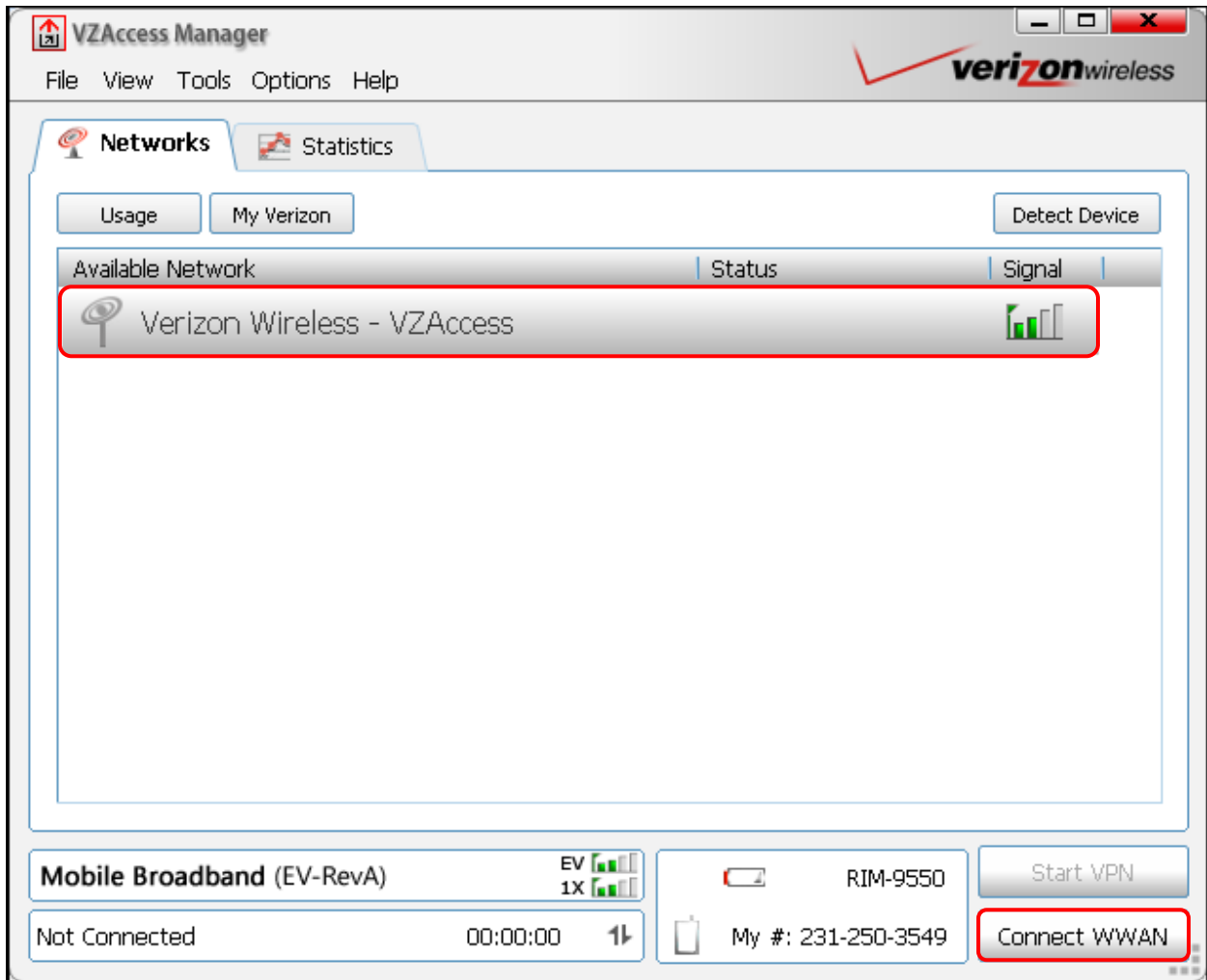
1. Using your USB cable, connect your BlackBerry to the computer.
2. Open the **VZAccess Manager**. VZAccess Manager will automatically detect your device.



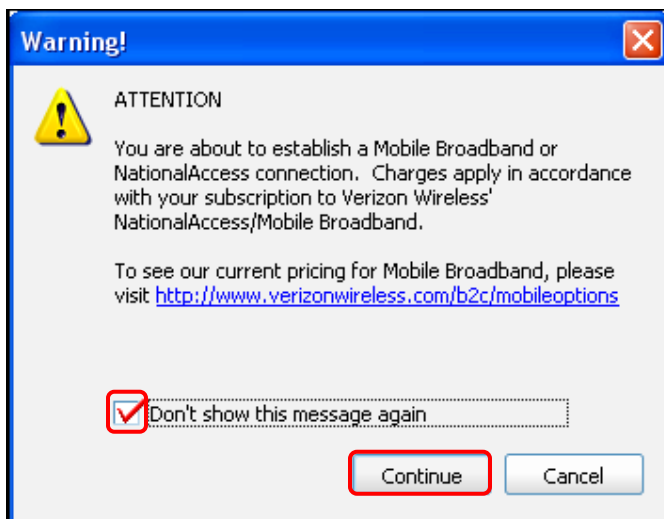
Note: If VZAccess Manager does not automatically find your device, you can manually click **Detect Device**.



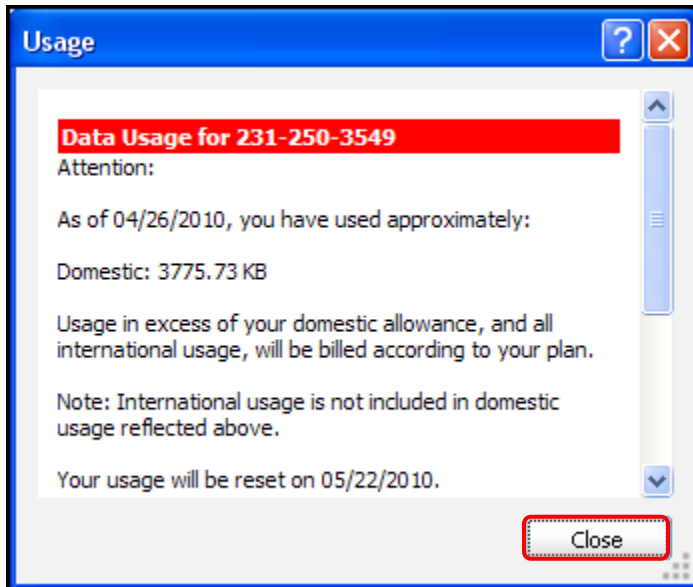
3. To tether using your BlackBerry and connect to the Internet, select **Verizon Wireless – VZAccess** and click **Connect WWAN**.



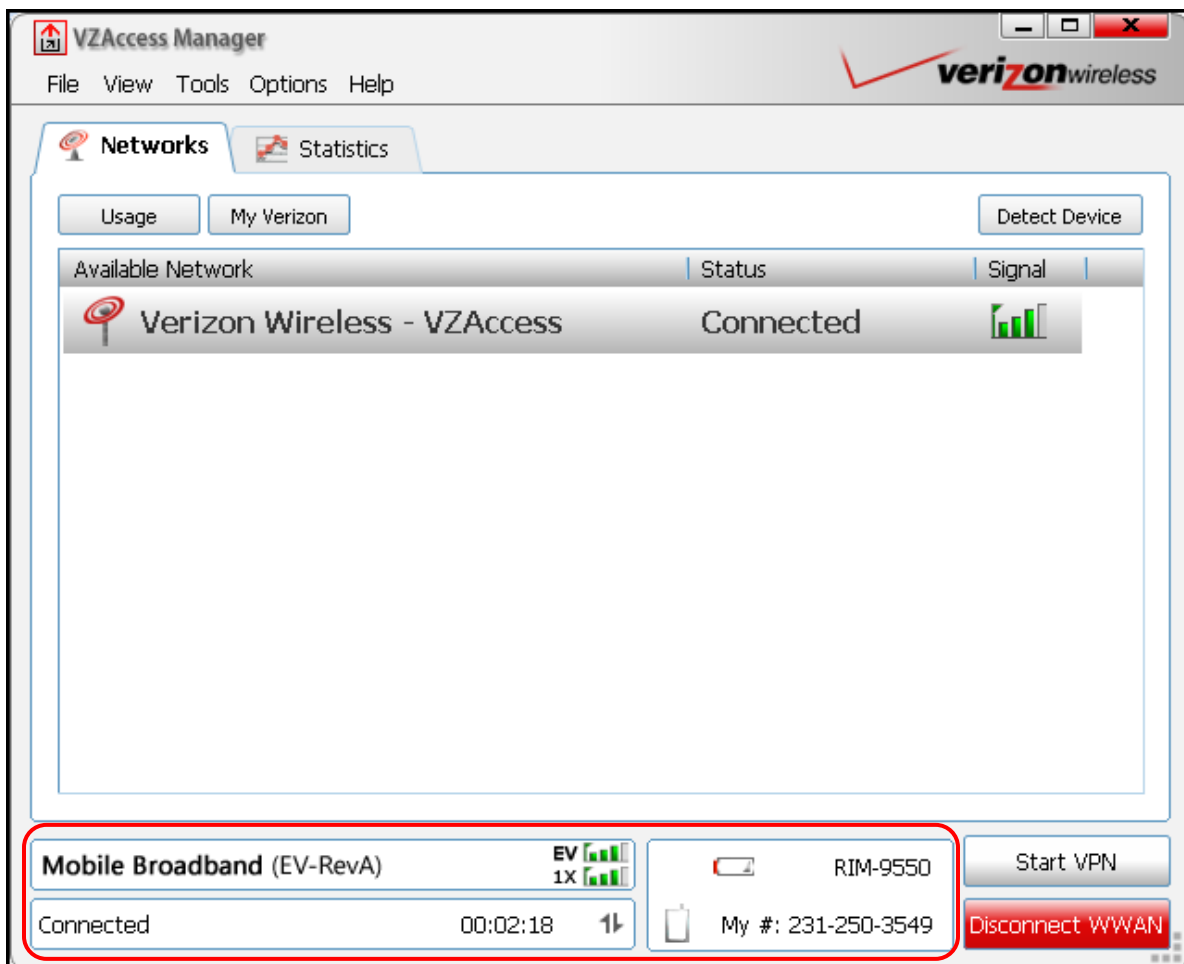
4. The first time you connect, you will receive a warning dialog box stating that you are about to connect to a MobileBroadband connection. To avoid seeing this dialog box in the future, click the **Don't show this message again** box and then click **Continue**.



5. A usage dialog box will appear. Disregard this by clicking **Close**.



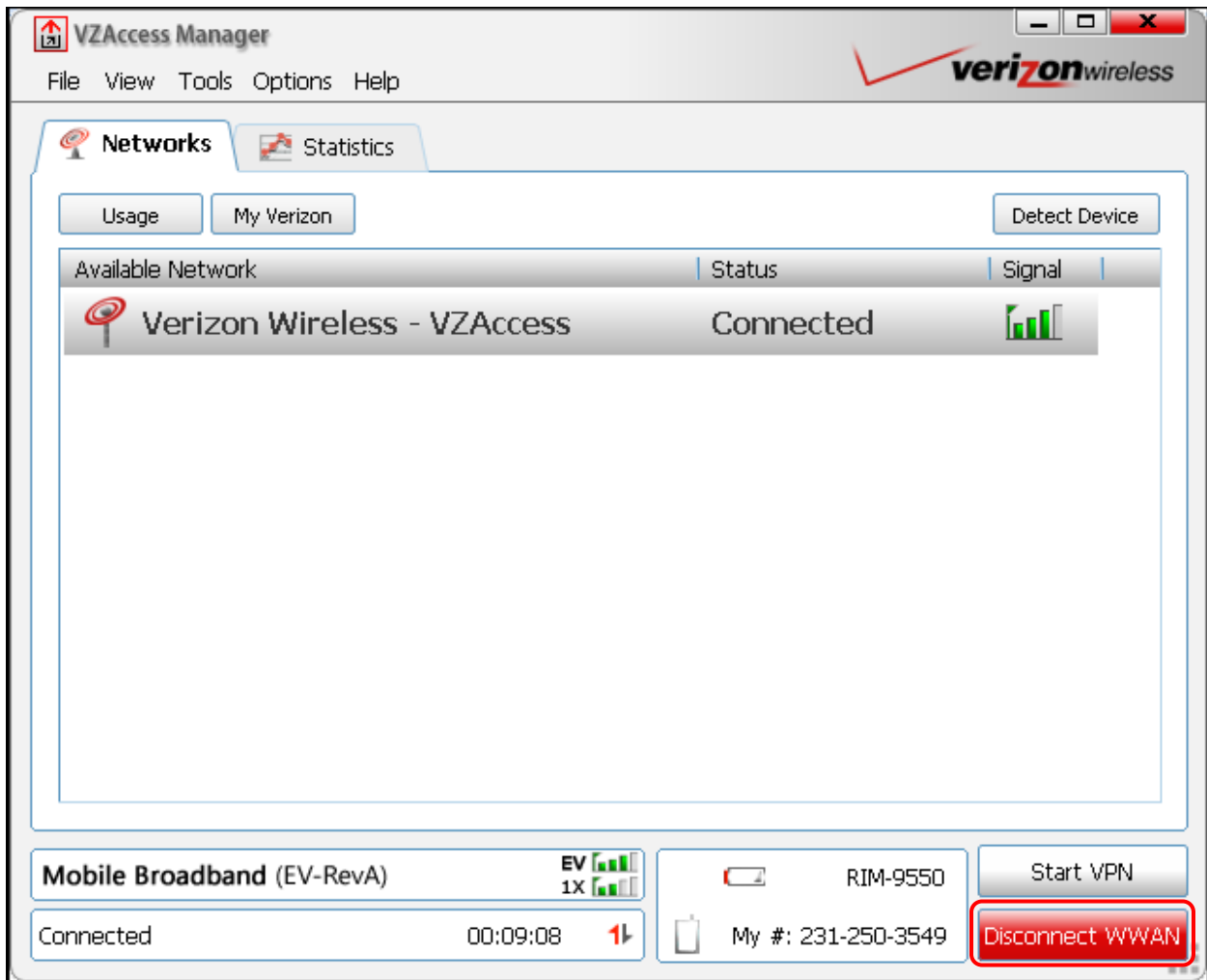
Your VZAccess Manager should show that you are connected in the bottom-left corner.



If you choose to minimize your VZAccess Manager, you can reopen it by selecting the icon in the system tray.



6. To disconnect from your BlackBerry device, click **Disconnect WWAN** in the bottom-right corner.
