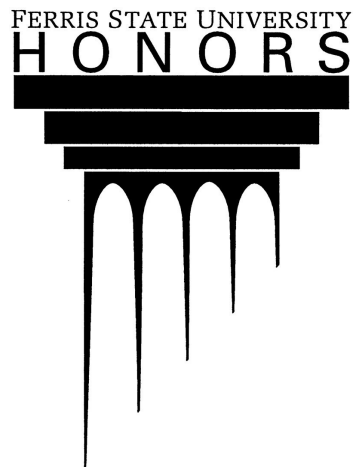

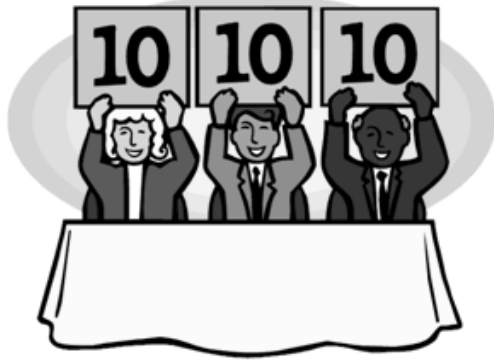
How You Can Get Involved:

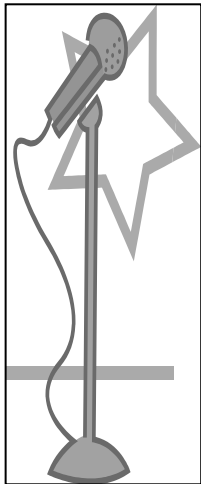
