How You Can Get Involved:

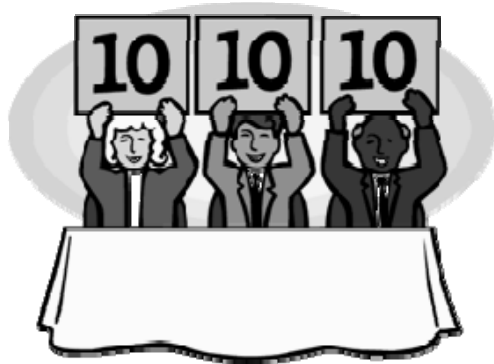
Tonight's show is going to be very interactive.

Tonight's show is going to be very interactive. Make sure your name has been entered at the entrance of the Dome Room for a chance at the door prizes.

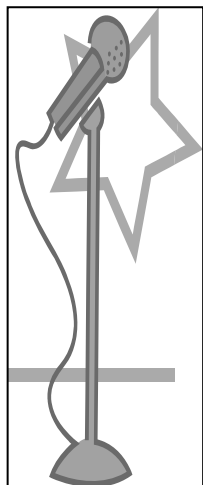
