Pass rates for the Control group remained the same in Fall 07 and Fall 08. The Non-SLA pass rate average (76%) in Fall 07 increased by 2.0 in Fall 08.

Pass rates were 24% higher in the SLA section in Fall 07 while the Control group was 4% higher and Non-SLA sections were 10% lower.
