The SLA section had a pass rate of 84% which was 9% higher than the control sections but 1% lower than the non-SLA sections. The SLA section and control section had fewer failures with 5%, while the non-SLA sections had 8%. The number of withdrawals for the SLA section was 5% while the control section had 10% and the non-SLA sections had 9%. The pass rate for the SLA section remained about the same in spring 08. The pass rate for the control group was 9% lower than the SLA section and 7% lower than the spring 08 control group. The non-SLA pass rate average in spring 08 (69%) increased by 16% in spring 09.

Note that SLA sections had lower HSGPA's and ACT scores, but the same pass rate.

The pass rate for the SLA section was 94% which was 13% higher than the non-SLA sections. There were no failures in the SLA sections in spring 08 and spring 09. The SLA section had 8% withdrawals while the non-SLA sections had 6% withdrawals as well as 5% failures. The pass rates for the non-SLA sections in spring 08 and spring 09 were similar.

Note that SLA sections had lower HSGPA's and ACT scores.

This course had a 90% pass rate with 10% failures and 5% withdrawals. The control section had 4% failures and 11% withdrawals while the pass rate was the same as the SLA pass rate. The non-SLA sections had 30% less students pass which was similar to spring 08. ACT scores and HSGPA's are the same for all sections so the difference could be due to instructors teaching the different sections. Since the SLA and control group results are similar, there will not be SLA added to BIOL 108 in fall 09.

The control sections had 8% withdrawals and 15% failures. In spring 08 both the SLA and control sections had a 79% pass rate. It appears that SLA is effective with student's passing CHEM 114.

Pass rates were similar in spring 08 but there were 11% withdrawals in the SLA sections and 11% in the non SLA sections. A large cohort of honors students enrolled in the SLA sections which could be the reason for the very high pass rate.
