NURS 511: Organizational and Systems Leadership

# **Course Description**

This course prepares the graduate nursing student to transform care environments utilizing effective collaboration and communication skills in inter-professional team settings. Students will analyze key issues and challenges affecting outcomes and learn how to be an effective organizational and systems leader.

3 credits

#### **Course Outcomes**

- Coordinate an inter-professional health care team demonstrating effective leadership skills, communication, decision-making, and accountability (Collaborative Leadership). Assessment method: Simulated inter-professional scenario – via discussion board and/or online meeting sessions
- 2. Use complexity, organizational, and leadership theories and science to support an effective change strategy to provide culturally responsive, high-quality, evidence-based care delivery and outcomes. (Theoretical Base for Practice; Scholarship for practice). Assessment method: Group presentation
- 3. Analyze key issues and challenges in health care facing the nurse leader. (Health Care Environment).

Assessment method: Individual paper

**4.** Design models of care using the best evidence and technology (Professionalism). Assessment method: Individual presentation
