

Language Placement for SPANISH, FRENCH and GERMAN:

The **WEB-CAPE** is a free exam used for placing students in the appropriate language course for the following languages: SPANISH, FRENCH and GERMAN. The WEB-CAPE exam is used for placement purposes only. Students wishing to receive college credit through examination should contact the Office of Institutional Research and testing at (231) 591-3628 to inquire about the CLEP exam.

We recommend that students take the WEB-CAPE prior to registration. To do this students **must**:

- 1) Direct a web browser to <http://webcape.byuhtrsc.org/?acct=ferris>
- 2) Enter the password (*bulldogs1*) to gain access to the exam
- 3) Take the WEB-CAPE exam for the preferred language
- 4) Print the score at the end of the exam and save this for future reference
- 5) Enroll in the course determined by the WEB-CAPE score **AND** the Years of High School Language Courses taken (see chart below)
- 6) Follow the procedures listed below if there are any discrepancies or concerns

WEB-CAPE score		Years of High School Language Courses	Course to be taken
0-159*	<u>and</u>	0-2 years of high school language courses	101 SPAN/FREN/GERM**
160-249*	<u>and</u>	1-3 years of high school language courses	102 SPAN/FREN/GERM**
250-374*	<u>and</u>	2-4 years of high school language courses	201 SPAN/FREN/GERM**
375 +	<u>and</u>	Contact Instructor for appropriate course placement	

* Students who attain a higher or lower score than what is indicated for the amount of language courses taken at the high school level must contact a member in the discipline in which they are enrolling. Instructors will administer a standardized oral proficiency exam to place the student in the appropriate level.

** Placement is subject to change in accordance to the Instructor's observation of the student during the first week of class. Student should contact the Instructor during the first week of class if he/she feels inappropriately placed.
