BULLDOG BITES

✓**FSU BASKETBALL AT A GLANCE:** The Ferris State men's basketball team hosts archival and nationally 15th-ranked Grand Valley State in a "Big Monday" matchup this Monday evening (Jan. 12) starting at 8 p.m. (EST) inside FSU's Jim Wink Arena at Big Rapids, Mich. The Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) outing opens a five-game homestand for the Bulldogs. In conjunction with the game, the Ferris Athletics Department will give away t-shirts to the first 200 FSU students in attendance at the contest. Second semester classes begin at Ferris on Monday as well.

✓**MEDIA COVERAGE:** The game is slated to be carried live by WBRN (1460 AM or 107.7 FM) with Jason DaDay handling the play-by-play duties. A live audio/video pay-per-view webcast will also be offered by B2 Networks. Live internet statistics will also be available. Visit the FSU Athletics Website at www.ferris.edu/sports and click on internet event schedule for a complete list of all available links.

✓**TICKET INFO:** Tickets for Monday's doubleheader against Grand Valley State will be available at the door starting one hour prior to the women's 6 p.m. (EST) tipoff. All single-game general admission ticket prices are \$7. FSU students are admitted free with ID. For more information on home ticket sales, please contact the FSU Athletics Ticket Office at (231) 591-2888.

✓**EARLIER THIS YEAR:** Earlier this year (12/1/08), the Bulldog women opened Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) action with a 74-64 road triumph over Grand Valley State in Allendale, Mich., while the men's squad narrowly lost to the nationally-ranked Lakers by a 72-62 count inside GVSU's Fieldhouse Arena.

✓**RECENT HISTORY:** Last season (2/23/08), the Bulldogs drew a modern Wink Arena record crowd of 2,430 fans for the regular-season men's basketball finale against the Lakers, which was also played in front of the first-ever live television audience from the arena. The official women's halftime attendance of 1,640 fans for the "Fill The Wink" contest also represented the largest crowd ever to watch the FSU women play in the 2,400-seat facility. Ferris has broke its own men's basketball arena attendance mark against GVSU each of the last three seasons and four of the top six crowds in the building's history have come against Grand Valley State. The Bulldogs have had more than 2,000 fans for the contest versus the Lakers each of the last two years as 2,120 fans jammed the place two years ago (2/24/07) before the record was broke again last season.

✓**CASH OFFERING:** Ferris State students will have an opportunity to win cash at each Bulldog basketball doubleheader the rest of the season. The FSU Athletics Department will give away a \$100 certificate at each of the Bulldogs' 11 GLIAC doubleheaders this campaign. In order to win the prize on a given day, students must be in attendance prior to halftime of the women's basketball contest. A raffle drawing will be held to determine the winner in the second half of the men's game.

✓**RECENT RESULTS:** The Bulldogs split a two-game league road trip this past weekend. FSU posted an impressive 86-59 GLIAC victory to snap Lake Superior State's five game-winning streak in Thursday's (Jan. 8) game

at Sault Ste. Marie, Mich. However, the Bulldogs suffered a 93-84 setback in Saturday's (Jan. 10) conference contest to Saginaw Valley State at University Center, Mich. The Cardinals jumped out to a 39-29 halftime lead, and increased the advantage to as many as 21 points in the second half before the Bulldogs rallied late. FSU trimmed SVSU's 21-point lead down to only two points at 84-82 with 1:48 to play, but the Cardinals closed the game on 9-2 run from the free throw line to seal the victory. Ferris shot 59% from the floor at LSSU but only 39% at SVSU.

✓**LEADING THE WAY:** Sophomore forward/center Justin Keenan (Grand Rapids/Ottawa Hills) tallied a game-high 25 points for FSU in the win at LSSU while junior guard Josh Young (Ypsilanti) added 14 points, freshman guard Dontae Molden (Detroit/Pershing) netted 11 points and sophomore guard Darien Gay (Detroit/Henry Ford) contributed 10 points. All 11 Bulldog players in uniform saw action in the victory. In Saturday's game, FSU was paced by Gay, who tallied a team-high 18 points on the strength of four three-point baskets late in the game. Young added 16 points, Keenan netted 14 points and sophomore guard Matt DeHart (Greenville) finished with 10 points.

✓**THE RANKINGS:** While the Bulldogs are not ranked in the current National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) National Poll, FSU did receive 18 points and was listed second among other teams receiving votes in the 2008-09 NABC preseason poll (Oct. 30). Three FSU losses have come to teams ranked in the top 25 this year, including number one-ranked Findlay, Grand Valley State and Northern Kentucky. GVSU was ranked 15th in last week's (Jan. 6) national rankings.

✓**LAST SEASON:** Ferris posted a 10-19 overall record and was 5-13 in GLIAC play with nine freshmen in the program during the 2007-08 season. FSU previously advanced to the NCAA-II Tournament in both 2004-05 and 2005-06 after claiming back-to-back league titles in 2003-04 and 2004-05. The Bulldogs also reached the NCAA-II Sweet Sixteen in '04-05.

✓**HEAD COACH BILL SALL:** A 1994 Calvin graduate, seventh-year FSU head coach Bill Sall previously held assistant coaching positions at Calvin (1992-95), Ferris State (1995-98) and Hillsdale (1998-02) prior to being named Ferris State's 11th head coach. The Zeeland, Mich., native served as Ferris' interim head coach for a portion of the 1995-96 campaign and led the Bulldogs to a 5-8 mark. Before joining the coaching ranks, Sall was a standout player at Calvin from 1985-90. He twice (1989-90) received second-team National Association of Basketball Coaches Division III All-America honors and led Calvin to three Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAA) championships, four NCAA-III Tournament bids and the 1990 NCAA-III Final Four. Sall has a current 97-101 (.490) career mark.

MORE BULLDOG NOTES

✓ **WELCOME BACK:** The Bulldogs welcomed back eight letterwinners and four starters from last season's squad. FSU has two seniors who play this year in forwards **Mark Gildersleeve** and **Jason Holder (Saginaw/Arthur Hill)**. Sophomore **Justin Keenan** was the squad's leading scorer (16.9 ppg.) and rebounder (6.9 rpg.) last season.

✓ **NEW TO CAMPUS:** The Bulldogs have seven newcomers on this season's roster, including five transfers and two freshmen. Three of the transfer players are from the junior college ranks. The two exceptions are Central Michigan senior transfer **Jon Yeazel (Middleville/Thornapple-Kellogg)** and junior guard/forward **Austin Randel**. Yeazel will sit out this season as a redshirt. Randel averaged a team-high 20.7 points while starting all 27 contests at NCAA-II North Greenville (S.C.) last campaign.

✓ **WHAT A CHANGE:** The Bulldogs had posted only a 21-82 (.204) mark in the four seasons prior to head coach **Bill Sall's** arrival, but have since went 92-93 (.497) and claimed two divisional titles while making two NCAA-II Tournament appearances in his seven seasons at the helm. FSU won only four games (4-22) the year before Sall arrived in 2001-02. Ferris has recorded six consecutive seasons with 10 wins or more under Sall's direction after previously winning eight games or fewer four-straight years prior to his arrival.

✓ **THE BULLDOG TRADITION:** The 2008-09 campaign marks the 81st season of Bulldog men's basketball. The program began in 1925 although Ferris did not field a team from 1942-45 due to World War II. FSU has compiled a 959-900 (.516) all-time mark. The Bulldogs have won 11 GLIAC titles, made eight NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and reached the 1988 NCAA-II Elite Eight. Ferris captured a league-record four consecutive GLIAC titles from 1986-90.

✓ **THE BULLDOG ROSTER:** Ferris' current 2008-09 roster includes three seniors, four juniors, five sophomores and three freshmen. Eight of the 15 players are guards while the remaining seven are frontcourt players. Fourteen of the 15 players on the Bulldogs' 2008-09 roster hail from Michigan.

✓ **BIG HOMESTAND:** The Bulldogs open a five-game homestand with Monday's contest against Grand Valley State. FSU hosts Tiffin on Thursday (Jan. 15) and Ashland on Saturday (Jan. 17) before concluding the homestand against Wayne State (Jan. 22) and Northwood (Jan. 24).

✓ **NOTES FROM THE KUYPER WIN:** Ferris' 115 total points versus Kuyper (Jan. 5) is the Bulldogs' highest figure in the 10-year history of the current Wink Arena and marked the first time FSU had scored 110 points or more since recording a 110-104 overtime victory over Indianapolis at home back during the 2004-05 season (12/21/04) Additionally, the 115 points recorded by FSU are the second-most by a Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) team in a game this season following Grand Valley State's 116 total points against Marygrove (12/28) FSU's 23 steals in the Kuyper game surpassed the previous school single-game record of 22 steals set on two different occasions.

✓ **DAWG LEADER:** FSU's **Justin Keenan** is currently averaging a team-high 20.5 points and 6.8 rebounds in 12 regular-season games this year, including a career-high 33 points versus Olivet (Nov. 25). The 6-6 Keenan has reached double-figure scoring in all 12 games and has totaled 20 points or more in six outings this year. He was named GLIAC North Division Player of the Week earlier this season (Nov. 25).

✓ **FSU PICKED FIFTH:** Ferris State was picked to finish fifth in the 2008-09 GLIAC Men's Basketball North Division Preseason Poll, which was announced during the league's second annual media day teleconference (Oct. 30) held this season. The poll was chosen by selected members of the media and the GLIAC's Sports Information Directors. The 30-member group tabbed Grand Valley State and Findlay to win the conference's North and South Division titles, respectively. The Bulldogs totaled 69 points in the balloting while finishing fifth in the North Division.

✓ **COACHING STAFF:** FSU head coach **Bill Sall** returns his coaching staff intact from a year ago, including top assistant coach **Cory Anderson**. Anderson, who played for Ferris from 1996-98, is in his 10th season as a full-time assistant. Volunteer Assistant Coach **Bill Killian** also returns for his seventh season on Sall's staff. Longtime West Michigan high school coach **Dave Schlump**, who formerly coached at Cedar Springs (Mich.), will be in his fifth campaign as a volunteer assistant for the Bulldogs while former Cornerstone University standout **Andy Bronkema**, who teaches at Big Rapids' Crossroads Charter Academy, is in his second season as a volunteer assistant at FSU.

✓ **PRESEASON ALL-GLIAC:** FSU's **Justin Keenan**, who averaged 15.9 points and 6.9 rebounds per contest in his initial collegiate season a year ago, was one of five players named to the Preseason All-GLIAC North Division squad in voting by the league's member head coaches. Five players were also named to the South Division team with Findlay's Josh Bostic earning GLIAC Preseason Player of the Year laurels.

✓ **SCOUTING GVSU:** Grand Valley State, which claimed a third consecutive GLIAC North Division title last season, is led in scoring by sophomore forward Justin Ringler (12.6 ppg), who's a native of Reed City. The Lakers, who are guided by fifth-year head coach Ric Wesley, were 36-1 overall and reached the NCAA-II Elite Eight during the 2007-08 campaign. Grand Valley State holds a 9-3 overall record this year and is 4-3 in the GLIAC following Saturday's (Jan. 10) 79-66 league road loss at Lake Superior State. The Lakers were listed 15th in the latest (Jan. 6) National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division II Top 25 poll. GVSU was 18-0 in GLIAC action last season.

✓ **SERIES INFORMATION:** Ferris holds a 46-44 advantage heading into Monday's 91st meeting with GVSU. The Lakers, however, have won eight-straight meetings and recorded a 72-62 triumph in the most recent game (12/1/08) earlier this year at Allendale, Mich. FSU has won five of the last 14 series' contests overall. Ferris' last win was a 79-63 win three years ago (12/8/05) at Jim Wink Arena. FSU head coach **Bill Sall** currently holds a 5-11 career coaching mark versus GVSU.

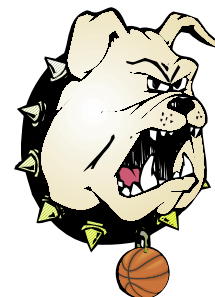
