2008-09 Ferris State Record: 9-8, 7-5 GLIAC

BULLDOG BITES

✓**FSU BASKETBALL AT A GLANCE:** The Ferris State men's basketball team embarks on a four-game Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) road swing by heading to Michigan's Upper Peninsula this week. The Bulldogs will face Northern Michigan Thursday (Jan. 29) at 7:30 p.m. (EST) in Marquette, Mich. Ferris then takes on Michigan Tech Saturday (Jan. 31) with tipoff set for 3 p.m. (EST) at Houghton, Mich. FSU has won six of its last eight games to date this season heading into the trip.

✓**MEDIA COVERAGE:** Both games are slated to be carried live by WBRN (1460 AM or 107.7 FM) with Rob Bentley handling the play-by-play duties although Thursday's game at NMU may be delayed due to high school basketball coverage. A live audio/video pay-per-view webcast will be offered for Thursday's game by B2 Networks while MTU will provide its own pay-per-view webcast on Saturday. ✓**TICKET INFO:** Ticket information along with travel directions for this week's games can be obtained by directly contacting the MTU and NMU Athletics Departments, respectively. Michigan Tech's main office number is (906) 487-3070 while NMU can be reached by dialing (906) 227-2105.

✓**THE STANDINGS:** The Bulldogs currently sit third in the GLIAC North Division and fourth overall in the league with a 7-5 conference mark. Lake Superior State (9-3) leads the North with Grand Valley State (8-4) one game in front of the Bulldogs. Findlay (12-0) heads the overall rankings, but is the only team from the South Division in front of the top three North Division schools. Michigan Tech (6-6) is one game behind FSU while Northern Michigan is 4-8 in GLIAC play to date.

✓**CASH OFFERING:** Ferris State students will have an opportunity to win cash at each Bulldog basketball doubleheader the rest of the season. The FSU Athletics Department will give away a \$100 certificate at each of the Bulldogs' 11 GLIAC doubleheaders this campaign. In order to win the prize on a given day, students must be in attendance prior to halftime of the women's basketball contest. A raffle drawing will be held to determine the winner in the second half of the men's game.

✓**LAST WEEK:** Ferris State split a pair of league home games this past week at Jim Wink Arena in Big Rapids, Mich. FSU topped Wayne State 76-72 in a thrilling overtime contest on Thursday (Jan. 22) before seeing its four-game winning streak stopped by Northwood in a 80-65 setback on Saturday (Jan. 24). Sophomore forward/center **Justin Keenan (Grand Rapids/Ottawa Hills)** tallied a game-high 32 points against Wayne State with FSU also receiving 14 points from junior guard **Josh Young (Ypsilanti)** and 13 by freshman guard **Dontae Molden (Detroit/Pershing)**. Three Bulldog players reached double-figure scoring in the setback to Northwood. **Josh Young** led the way with a game-high tying 19 points, sophomore guard **Matt DeHart (Greenville)** netted 13 points and **Justin**

Keenan chipped in with 12 points and 12 rebounds. The victory over WSU was only the Bulldogs' third against the Warriors since the 1995-96 season.

✓**BIG OVERTIME EFFORT:** FSU's **Justin Keenan** averaged 22 points and 8.5 rebounds in the Bulldogs' two games last week. The 6-6 Keenan netted a game-high 32 points with five rebounds and three steals in FSU's thrilling 76-72 overtime triumph Thursday (Jan. 22) over Wayne State. He then added 12 points and 12 boards in a double-double effort Saturday (Jan. 24) against Northwood. In the extra period versus WSU, Keenan scored nine of FSU's 11 points, including seven points from the free throw line where he finished 14-of-17 on the night in helping the Bulldogs secure their fourth consecutive victory. The overtime game was FSU's first since a 75-70 overtime home setback to nationally-ranked Findlay two years ago (1/27/07).

✓**LUCKY NUMBER TEN:** Ferris, which is currently 9-8 overall and 7-5 in GLIAC play this season, needs only one more win to register its seventh-straight season with 10 or more victories under current seventh-year head coach **Bill Sall**. FSU tallied double-digit win totals 28-straight years from 1967 to 1995 under former head coaches and current Bulldog Athletics Hall of Fame members **Jim Wink** and **Tom Ludwig**, but had done so only twice in the seven seasons prior to Sall's appointment in 2002.

✓**THE RANKINGS:** While the Bulldogs are not ranked in the current National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) National Poll, FSU did receive 18 points and was listed second among other teams receiving votes in the 2008-09 NABC preseason poll (Oct. 30). Three FSU losses have come to teams ranked in the top 25 this year, including number one-ranked Findlay, Grand Valley State and Northern Kentucky.

✓**LAST SEASON:** Ferris posted a 10-19 overall record and was 5-13 in GLIAC play with nine freshmen in the program during the 2007-08 season. FSU previously advanced to the NCAA-II Tournament in both 2004-05 and 2005-06 after claiming back-to-back league titles in 2003-04 and 2004-05. The Bulldogs also reached the NCAA-II Sweet Sixteen in '04-05.

✓**HEAD COACH BILL SALL:** A 1994 Calvin graduate, seventh-year FSU head coach **Bill Sall** previously held assistant coaching positions at Calvin (1992-95), Ferris State (1995-98) and Hillsdale (1998-02) prior to being named Ferris State's 11th head coach. The Zeeland, Mich., native served as Ferris' interim head coach for a portion of the 1995-96 campaign and led the Bulldogs to a 5-8 mark. Before joining the coaching ranks, Sall was a standout player at Calvin from 1985-90. He twice (1989-90) received second-team National Association of Basketball Coaches Division III All-America honors and led Calvin to three Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAA) championships, four NCAA-III Tournament bids and the 1990 NCAA-III Final Four. Sall has a current 101-102 (.498) career mark.

MORE BULLDOG NOTES

✓ **WELCOME BACK:** The Bulldogs welcomed back eight letterwinners and four starters from last season's squad. FSU has two seniors who play this year in forwards **Mark Gildersleeve (Byron Center)** and **Jason Holder**. Sophomore **Justin Keenan** was the squad's leading scorer (16.9 ppg.) and rebounder (6.9 rpg.) last season.

✓ **NEW TO CAMPUS:** The Bulldogs have seven newcomers on this season's roster, including five transfers and two freshmen. Three of the transfer players are from the junior college ranks. The two exceptions are Central Michigan senior transfer **Jon Yeazel (Middleville/Thornapple-Kellogg)** and junior guard/forward **Austin Randel (Lake City/McBain)**. Yeazel will sit out this season as a redshirt. Randel averaged 20.7 points while starting all 27 contests at NCAA-II North Greenville (S.C.) last campaign.

✓ **WHAT A CHANGE:** The Bulldogs had posted only a 21-82 (.204) mark in the four seasons prior to head coach **Bill Sall's** arrival, but have since went 96-94 (.505) and claimed two divisional titles while making two NCAA-II Tournament appearances in his seven seasons at the helm. FSU won only four games (4-22) the year before Sall arrived in 2001-02. Ferris has recorded six consecutive seasons with 10 wins or more under Sall's direction after previously winning eight games or fewer four-straight years prior to his arrival.

✓ **THE BULLDOG TRADITION:** The 2008-09 campaign marks the 81st season of Bulldog men's basketball. The program began in 1925 although Ferris did not field a team from 1942-45 due to World War II. FSU has compiled a 963-901 (.517) all-time mark. The Bulldogs have won 11 GLIAC titles, made eight NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and reached the 1988 NCAA-II Elite Eight. Ferris captured a league-record four consecutive GLIAC titles from 1986-90.

✓ **THE BULLDOG ROSTER:** Ferris' current 2008-09 roster includes three seniors, four juniors, five sophomores and three freshmen. Eight of the 15 players are guards while the remaining seven are frontcourt players. Fourteen of the 15 players on the Bulldogs' 2008-09 roster hail from Michigan.

✓ **NEXT WEEK:** After this week's trip to the Upper Peninsula, FSU will make another trek next week with games at Hillsdale (Feb. 5) and nationally top-ranked Findlay (Feb. 7). After the two trips, the Bulldogs will play four of their final six GLIAC games inside the confines of Wink Arena.

✓ **GLIAC LEADERS:** Ferris sophomore **Justin Keenan** currently leads all GLIAC players in scoring this season with a 20.5 points per game average. He is also first in offensive boards (3.6 pg.) and fifth in rebounds (7.2 rpg.) Bulldog sophomore **Darien Gay** is second among the league leaders in three-point field goal percentage (.552) leader along with third in both assists (4.4 apg.) and steals (1.9 spg.) to date Freshman **Dontae Molden** ranks second in the GLIAC in assists (4.7 apg.) while junior **Josh Young** is eighth in scoring (15.5 ppg.) Ferris currently leads the GLIAC in assists (17.4 pg.) and offensive rebounds (15.1 pg.) while ranking second in scoring (79.6 ppg.), steals (9.1 pg.) and turnover margin (+2.82) Keenan's 114 made free throws and 150 attempts (.760) for all games this year both top the league charts. He also shot the most free throws of all GLIAC players last season, hitting 167 of 212 (.788).

✓ **NATIONAL STATS:** Ferris presently ranks 254th out of 270 NCAA Division II teams ranked in fouls per game this season as the Bulldogs are averaging 22.6 personal fouls per contest. FSU is listed 25th nationally in assists, 37th in assist/turnover ratio, 44th in turnover margin, 47th in steals and 53rd in scoring offense. **Justin Keenan** ranks 23rd nationally in scoring.

✓ **LEADING THE WAY:** FSU's **Justin Keenan** is currently averaging a team-high 20.5 points and 7.2 rebounds in 17 regular-season games this year, including a career-high 33 points versus Olivet (Nov. 25). The 6-6 Keenan has reached double-figure scoring in all 17 games and has totaled 20 points or more in nine outings this year. He was named GLIAC North Division Player of the Week earlier this season (Nov. 25). Keenan notched his 800th career point versus Northwood last Saturday.

✓ **PRESEASON ALL-GLIAC:** FSU's **Justin Keenan**, who averaged 15.9 points and 6.9 rebounds per contest in his initial collegiate season a year ago, was one of five players named to the Preseason All-GLIAC North Division squad in voting by the league's member head coaches. Five players were also named to the South Division team with Findlay's Josh Bostic earning GLIAC Preseason Player of the Year laurels. Ferris was picked to finish fifth in the 2008-09 GLIAC Men's Basketball North Division Preseason Poll, which was chosen by selected members of the media and the GLIAC's Sports Information Directors.

✓ **SCOUTING NMU:** Northern Michigan holds a 9-8 overall record along with a 4-8 GLIAC mark entering Thursday's contest. The Wildcats, who are guided by 23rd-year head coach Dean Ellis, were picked to finish sixth in the 2008-09 GLIAC North Division Preseason Media Poll. They are led in scoring by junior guard Marc Renelique (15.2 ppg). The Wildcats have lost five-straight games to date this year after Saturday's (Jan. 24) 74-69 league home setback to Saginaw Valley State. NMU was 7-20 overall in 2007-08 and placed tied for fifth (6-12) in the divisional standings.

✓ **SCOUTING MTU:** MTU, which hosts GVSU Thursday (Jan. 29) prior to facing FSU, enters the week with a 9-8 record and a current 6-6 conference ledger. The Huskies, under 15th-year head coach Kevin Luke, have lost three-straight games including a 58-51 GLIAC home setback to Lake Superior State on Saturday (Jan. 24). The Huskies were 13-14 overall during the 2007-08 campaign and compiled a second-place tying 8-10 GLIAC North Division record. MTU, which is led in scoring by senior guard Robby Springborn (13.3 ppg), was picked to finish second in the 2008-09 GLIAC North Division Preseason Coaches Poll.

✓ **SERIES INFORMATION:** Ferris holds a 46-64 all-time series' record to date against NMU. The Bulldogs, though, have claimed 11 of the last 14 series' contests, including a 64-59 home triumph in the most recent game (2/7/08). FSU head coach **Bill Sall** is presently 11-3 against Northern Michigan in his coaching career Meanwhile, the Bulldogs trail MTU 51-49 all-time although FSU has won six of the last nine games heading into Saturday's 101st series' meeting. FSU holds a 6-6 all-time mark versus MTU under Sall, but suffered a 65-63 home loss in the last game (2/9/08).

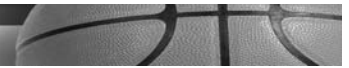
