BULLDOG BITES

✓**FSU BASKETBALL AT A GLANCE:** The Ferris State men's basketball team will visit archrival Grand Valley State for a Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Tournament quarterfinal game on Tuesday, March 3, with tipoff set for 8 p.m. (EST) inside the GVSU Fieldhouse Arena at Allendale, Mich.

✓**MEDIA COVERAGE:** The contest will be carried live by WBRN (1460 AM or 107.7 FM) with Rob Bentley handling the play-by-play duties. In addition, live internet statistics will also be available at www.gvsulakers.com. Visit the FSU Athletics Website at www.ferris.edu/sports and click on internet event schedule for a complete list of all available links.

✓**TICKET INFO:** Tickets are available through the Grand Valley State Athletics Ticket Office by calling (616) 331-3200 or going online to the GVSU site at www.gvsulakers.com and clicking on the "Tickets" icon. Adult tickets are \$8 while (under 17) are \$5 and college students with ID are \$3. Grand Valley State's women's team will host Ashland in its tournament quarterfinal-round action prior to the men's game at 6 p.m. (EST).

✓**THE RECORDS:** The Bulldogs, who presently have won three of their last five outings, own a current 14-13 overall record and posted a third-place 12-10 mark in GLIAC North Division play. GVSU holds a 19-8 overall mark and finished second in the North Division with a 14-8 league record this campaign. FSU is the fifth overall seed in the tournament with the Lakers seeded fourth in the field.

✓**FSU TOURNEY NOTES:** The Bulldog men, who will be making their 10th all-time tournament appearance, own a 7-11 mark in nine previous trips to the annual event FSU advanced to the GLIAC Tournament Championship game in 2005-06 before dropping an 80-58 decision in the title contest (3/3/06) at Grand Valley State Ferris captured the 1997-98 league tourney title and will be making its fourth appearance in the last five years after missing the event a year ago FSU is 0-3 all-time versus GVSU in GLIAC Tournament action. This year's meeting will be the third-straight tourney game the Bulldogs have played against the Lakers as FSU also dropped a 72-59 quarterfinal decision at GVSU in its most recent league tourney bid two years ago (2/27/07).

✓**THE TOURNEY FIELD:** The other quarterfinal round games include Michigan Tech (#6 seed) at Hillsdale (#3 seed), Northwood (#8 seed) at Findlay (#1 seed) along with Wayne State (#7 seed) at Lake Superior State (#2 seed). The WSU-LSSU game will take place Tuesday at 7 p.m. (EST) with the NU-Findlay contest set to start at 7:30 p.m. (EST) and the MTU-HC matchup beginning at 8 p.m. (EST). The remaining teams will be reseeded after the quarterfinals and the semifinals and finals will be held Friday and Saturday, March 6-7, at the site of the highest remaining seed. Findlay is the top overall seed in the tournament.

✓**GLIAC TOURNEY NOTEBOOK:** The tournament remains on campus sites this season for the seventh year in a row. Prior to the 2002-03 season, the four previous tournaments were held at a neutral site location, with the final three taking place at the DeltaPlex in Grand Rapids, Mich The winner of this season's GLIAC Tournament will receive the league's automatic berth into the NCAA-II Midwest Regional Tournament slated for March 14-17 at a site to be determined.

✓**THE THIRD MEETING:** Tuesday's meeting will be the third time the Bulldogs and Lakers have met this season. GVSU recorded a 72-62 home triumph in the first league game for each team early (Dec. 1) this season at Allendale. However, FSU responded with a 74-67 triumph in a "Big Monday" matchup to start the second semester (Jan. 12) at Wink Arena in Big Rapids. In the first meeting, Pete Trammell led three Laker players in double-figures with 28 points to help offset a 22-point effort by FSU junior guard **Josh Young (Ypsilanti)**. GVSU had no answer for Bulldog sophomore forward/center **Justin Keenan (Grand Rapids/Ottawa Hills)** in the second game as he finished with 27 points and 12 boards.

✓**LAST WEEK:** The Bulldogs split a pair of league road games to wrap up regular-season play last week. FSU posted an impressive 72-50 road win on Thursday (Feb. 26) at Northwood before falling to Wayne State by an 88-80 count on Saturday (Feb. 28) in Detroit. Sophomore guard **Darrien Gay (Detroit/Henry Ford)** paced FSU with a game-high 19 points and five assists in the win at Northwood. FSU also received 14 points from both sophomore forward **Lou Williams (Muskegon Heights)** and junior guard **Josh Young**. The 6-2 Young paced Ferris with 18 points and **Justin Keenan** added 16 points at Wayne State with junior guard **Austin Randel (Lake City/McBain)** chipping in 12 points and freshman guard **Dontae Molden (Detroit/Pershing)** scoring 10 points in his return to his hometown.

✓**BACK IN THE LINEUP:** FSU's **Justin Keenan** returned to the floor in Saturday's regular-season finale at Wayne State after missing the previous two games with an ankle injury. The 6-6 Keenan totaled 16 points and nine rebounds while playing 24 minutes off the bench versus the Warriors. He originally suffered the injury in Ferris' 80-69 home win over Saginaw Valley State (Feb. 19) and did not play in the squad's last home game against Lake Superior State (Feb. 21) or Thursday's win at Northwood.

✓**HEAD COACH BILL SALL:** A 1994 Calvin graduate, seventh-year FSU head coach **Bill Sall** previously held assistant coaching positions at Calvin (1992-95), Ferris State (1995-98) and Hillsdale (1998-02) prior to being named Ferris State's 11th head coach. The Jenison, Mich., native served as Ferris' interim head coach for a portion of the 1995-96 campaign and led the Bulldogs to a 5-8 mark. Before joining the coaching ranks, Sall was a standout player at Calvin from 1985-90. He twice (1989-90) received second-team National Association of Basketball Coaches Division III All-America honors and led Calvin to three Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAA) championships, four NCAA-III Tournament bids and the 1990 NCAA-III Final Four. Sall has a current 106-107 (.498) career mark.

MORE BULLDOG NOTES

✓ **LAST SEASON:** Ferris posted a 10-19 overall record and was 5-13 in GLIAC play with nine freshmen in the program during the 2007-08 season. FSU previously advanced to the NCAA-II Tournament in both 2004-05 and 2005-06 after claiming back-to-back league titles in 2003-04 and 2004-05. The Bulldogs also reached the NCAA-II Sweet Sixteen in '04-05.

✓ **TEN MORE AGAIN:** This year marks the seventh-straight season with 10 or more victories for Ferris under seventh-year head coach **Bill Sall**. FSU tallied double-digit win totals 28-straight years from 1967 to 1995 under former head coaches Jim Wink and Tom Ludwig, but had done so only twice in the seven seasons prior to Sall's appointment in 2002.

✓ **TURN OF EVENTS:** The Bulldogs had posted only a 21-82 (.204) mark in the four seasons prior to head coach **Bill Sall's** arrival, but have since went 101-99 (.505) and claimed two divisional titles while making two NCAA-II Tournament appearances in his seven seasons at the helm. FSU won only four games (4-22) the year before Sall arrived in 2001-02. Including this year, Ferris has recorded seven consecutive seasons with 10 wins or more under Sall's direction after previously winning eight games or fewer four-straight years prior to his arrival. FSU posted its 100th victory since Sall's return in 2002 with its recent home win over Saginaw Valley State (Feb. 19).

✓ **THE BULLDOG TRADITION:** The 2008-09 campaign marks the 81st season of Bulldog men's basketball. The program began in 1925 although Ferris did not field a team from 1942-45 due to World War II. FSU has compiled a 968-906 (.517) all-time mark. The Bulldogs have won 11 GLIAC titles, made eight NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and reached the 1988 NCAA-II Elite Eight. Ferris captured a league-record four consecutive GLIAC titles from 1986-90.

✓ **THE BULLDOG ROSTER:** Ferris' current 2008-09 roster includes three seniors, four juniors, five sophomores and three freshmen. Eight of the 15 players are guards while the remaining seven are frontcourt players. Fourteen of the 15 players on the Bulldogs' 2008-09 roster hail from Michigan.

✓ **LEAGUE LEADER:** FSU sophomore **Justin Keenan** presently ranks as the GLIAC's leading scorer this season with a 20.2 points per game average. He's also ranked second in offensive rebounds (3.4 rpg.), fourth in field goal percentage (.552) and fourth in rebounds (7.3 rpg.). Keenan's 167 made free throws and 219 attempts (.763) for all games this year both top the league charts. He's reached double-figure scoring in 24 of his 25 games and has totaled 20 points or more 14 times.

✓ **GLIAC LEADERS:** Freshman **Dontae Molden** is first in the GLIAC in assists (4.9 apg.) to date while sophomore **Darion Gay** ranks second (4.5 apg.) Gay is also listed second in assist/turnover ratio (2.1), third in three-point field goal % (.482) and tied for fourth in steals (1.7 spg.). Junior **Josh Young** is eighth in scoring (14.4 ppg.) Ferris currently leads the GLIAC in offensive rebounds (14.3 pg.) while ranking second in scoring (77.3 ppg.), steals (8.7 pg.), assists (16.0 apg.) and turnover margin (+2.04) along with third in assist/turnover ratio (1.1).

✓ **NATIONAL STATS:** Ferris ranks 248th out of 270 NCAA Division II teams ranked in fouls per game this season according to the most recent (Feb. 23) NCAA-II National Statistics. The Bulldogs are averaging 22.1 personal fouls per contest. FSU is listed 42nd nationally in assists, 44th in assist/turnover ratio, 48th in steals, along with 50th in turnover margin, 53rd in free throw percentage and 58th in three-point %. **Justin Keenan** ranks 24th nationally in scoring and 50th in field goal percentage with **Darion Gay** 22nd in assist/turnover ratio.

✓ **NEARING THE MARK:** FSU's **Justin Keenan** currently has 966 career points in his second-year and notched his 950th career point versus SVSU (Feb. 19). He needs 34 more to become only the 26th player in school history to join the 1,000 career points club. The only player to score more than 2,000 points at FSU is all-time leading scorer Dennis Johnson with 2,312 (1969-73).

✓ **PRESEASON ALL-GLIAC:** FSU's **Justin Keenan**, who averaged 15.9 points and 6.9 rebounds per contest in his initial collegiate season a year ago, was one of five players named to the Preseason All-GLIAC North Division squad in voting by the league's member head coaches. Five players were also named to the South Division team with Findlay's Josh Bostic earning GLIAC Preseason Player of the Year laurels. Ferris was picked to finish fifth in the 2008-09 GLIAC Men's Basketball North Division Preseason Poll.

✓ **SCOUTING GRAND VALLEY STATE:** Grand Valley State, which claimed a third consecutive GLIAC North Division title last season, is led in scoring by senior forward Pete Trammell (13.3 ppg). The Lakers, who are guided by fifth-year head coach Ric Wesley, were 36-1 overall and reached the NCAA-II Elite Eight during the 2007-08 campaign. Grand Valley State holds a 19-8 overall record this year and finished 14-8 in the GLIAC following Saturday's (Feb. 28) 73-65 league road win at Northwood. GVSU is presently 14-2 overall at home this campaign.

✓ **SERIES INFORMATION:** Ferris holds a 47-44 advantage heading into Tuesday's 92nd meeting with GVSU. FSU won the most recent game (1/12/09) by a 74-67 count in Big Rapids. The Lakers had won eight-straight meetings prior to the setback and recorded a 72-62 triumph earlier this year (12/1/08) at Allendale, Mich. FSU has won six of the last 15 series' contests overall. Prior to its win in the most recent game, Ferris' last series' victory had come nearly three years ago (12/8/05) with a 79-63 triumph on its home floor at Jim Wink Arena. FSU head coach **Bill Sall** currently holds a 6-11 career coaching mark versus GVSU.

✓ **LAST TOURNEY MEETING:** Ferris had its season come to an end in the GLIAC Tournament with a 72-59 quarterfinal-round loss to Grand Valley State in its most recent tourney appearance two years ago (2/27/07) at Allendale. The Lakers jumped out to a 35-23 halftime edge and limited FSU to 33% shooting for the game. Mike Hall scored 20 points and Jason Jamerson added 12 points with Dan Redder chipping in 11 points for GVSU. The Bulldogs received 13 points from senior forward Terrance Shaw and 11 points on the perimeter by Jessie York. Ferris currently has only two players remaining on its roster from that particular game in senior forwards **Jason Holder** and **Mark Gildersleeve**, who combined to score four points and grab six rebounds in 17 minutes.

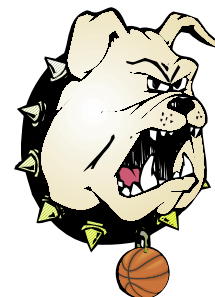

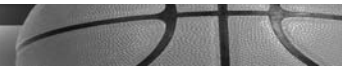
