

Final Report, Spring 2014

Program Statistics

- SLA was offered with 16 courses and 29 sections.
- SLA served 872 students in Spring 14 which was nearly the same as Spring 13.

New Courses and Initiatives

• BLAW 321 was the one new course offered in Spring 14.

Outcomes for Spring 14

- The pass rate for BIOL 108 in SLA was 83% while the control group had an 80% pass rate.
- The pass rate for BIOL 121 with SLA was 82% while the SLAC had a 77% pass rate.
- The pass rate for MATH 226 was 90%. The pass rate in spring 13 with SLA attached was 83%
- The pass rate for SLA for CHEM 114 was 91% while the control group had an 80% pass rate
- The pass rate for SLA for CHEM 103 was 90%. The pass rate was the same in Spring 13.
- There was a 100% pass rate in BLAW 321 with the SLA section. The SLAC had a 71% pass rate.

Changes for 2014-2015

- MRIS 204 and MRIS 211 no longer receive SLA support due to consistent 100% pass rate and no evidence that students were mandated to attend workshops. These classes are not high risk for failure which is one of the criteria for SLA.
- There are no new courses with SLA for fall 2014.
