Committee Name: Academic Policy and Standards Committee

Committee Membership:

- One faculty member from each college.
- One member from the librarian/counselor unit.
- Ex-officio: Academic Affairs Representative.

Structure:

- Two Co-Chairs
- One Knowledge/Information Manager
 - Take notes during meetings and share meeting minutes.
 - Keep SharePoint site organized and accessible to committee members.

Term and Term Limits:

- All members will serve three-year terms.
- Terms can be repeated consecutively with a limit of three consecutive terms.
- Ideally, no more than one-third of the committee will turn over in any given year.

Committee Charges:

- Study and evaluate existing educational policies and standards.
- Submit recommendations of educational policies and standards to the Senate for approval.
- Regularly review and advise the Senate on policies, procedures, and standards pertaining to academic regulations.

Work to Date:

- Discussed an alternative path for policy review at FSU in committee and with members of Academic Affairs and the SEC. The committee recommends continued discussion of the policy review process at FSU and the possible creation of a task force to explore options for policy review.
