## FERRIS STATE UNIVERSITY/MOTT COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER PLAN

**PROGRAM COORDINATOR: Dr. Anthony Baker**

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Admission requirement for transfer students:

1. Transfer students with fewer than 12 transferable credits at the time of application, must meet the current freshman admission criteria. The application will be considered for admission based upon the high school academic record.
2. Transfer students with 12 or more transferable credits at the time of application (including both English and Algebra) must have a minimum CGPA of 2.0. Students without an English and Algebra class will be required to submit an ACT/SAT score.

Graduation Requirements:

1. Minimum 2.0 CUMULATIVE grade average in all courses.
2. No grade lower than a "C" in course work included in the "major" 15 credits must be FSU credits; 15 credits must be 300/400 level.
3. Must complete an FSU approved academic minor, 50% must be FSU coursework.
4. 120 Minimum semester credits including general education requirements.
5. Residency requirement: 30 minimum FSU semester credits.
6. Minimum of 40 credits numbered 300 or higher (excluding community college credits).
