1. A 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admission into the program.
 2. A 2.00 cumulative GPA is required in the major and overall for graduation from the Dental Hygiene program.
 3. A minimum of 15 credits must be FSU credits and a minimum of 86 credits total.
 4. Students must meet FSU General Education requirements for an Associates of Applied Science degree delineated on the FSU General Education website, if the student does NOT get the MACRAO stamp.  5. FSU honors the MACRAO stamp on an official transcript as fulfilling lower level general education courses that **are not** programmatic or prerequisite requirements.
 6. A "C" or better grade must be earned to allow for course transfer to FSU.
 7. To determine how courses will transfer into Ferris, check the transfer equivalency grid: <http://www.ferris.edu/admissions/Transfer/WebPages/homepage1.cfm>
 8. A grade of a C or better must be earned (within two attempts) in MATH 110, MRIS 102, COMM 105 or 121, CHEM 114, BIOL 108 & 205, SOCY 121, PSYC 150, cultural enrichment course and ENGL 150. . These courses must be completed prior to applying for admission into the professional sequence (DHYG courses).  9. All science and math courses must be taken within 5 years of application to your professional sequence.
