<p>Qualification Policies for the Dental Hygiene Program</p> <p>A student must complete all qualifying courses with a C (2.0) or higher and have a 2.5 GPA to qualify for the professional sequence.</p> <p>A student may have one unsuccessful attempt at one or more of the qualifying courses listed. Earning a grade below a C (2.0) twice in any of the qualifying courses will require a withdrawal from</p>		

pre-dental hygiene. This policy applies to transfer students taking equivalent courses at their home schools. If a student is required to withdraw, the student may not reapply and receive pre-dental hygiene status for at least 5 years.

CCHS 101, CCHS 102, CCHS 103 and English 250 may be taken prior to entering the professional sequence; if not, then the courses must be taken during the semester listed on the program checklist.
