1. A 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admission into the program.
 2. A 2.00 cumulative GPA is required in the major and overall for graduation from the Health Information Technology program.
 3. A minimum of 15 credits must be FSU credits and a minimum of 70 credits total.
 4. Students must meet FSU General Education requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree delineated on the FSU General Education website, if the student does NOT get the MACRAO stamp. Learn more about general education courses at:
