- 2.5 college GPA
- It is recommended that applicants have a strong preparation in English, Speech/Communication, and Computer Science.
- This is an excellent B.S. degree option for students who are earning, or have earned, a health related associates degree.

APPLICATION

- Students may begin the program any semester. For proper tracking of courses, we encourage students to apply one year prior to attendance at Ferris.

TRANSFER PLAN

- Transfer of credit is awarded on a course-by-course basis.
- Transferable courses are those with grades of "C" (2.00 on a 4.00 scale) or better.
- The following is a list of courses students must complete to earn the degree. Community college equivalents are listed below and may be taken prior to transferring to Ferris. If a program will accept a course as a substitution, the word "sub" will follow the community college course number. Blank spaces in the community college column indicate there are no course equivalents or substitutions available.
