1. A 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admission into the program.
 2. A 2.5 cumulative GPA is required in the major and overall for graduation from the Medical Laboratory Technology program.
 3. A minimum of 15 credits must be FSU credits and a minimum of 92 credits total.
 4. Students must meet FSU General Education requirements for an Associates of Applied Science degree delineated on the FSU General Education website, if the student does NOT get the MACRAO stamp.  5. FSU honors the MACRAO stamp on an official transcript as fulfilling lower level general education courses that **are not** programmatic or prerequisite requirements.
 6. A "C" or better grade must be earned to allow for course transfer to FSU.

 8. A grade of a C or better must be earned (within two attempts) in MATH 117, CHEM 114, CHEM 214, BIOL 205, BIOL 108/286. These courses must be completed prior to applying for admission into the professional sequence (CLLS courses).  9. All science and math courses must be taken within 5 years of application to your professional sequence.
