For Admission to the Professional Nursing Sequence: These courses must be completed by the end of the Spring Semester to qualify for entry into the professional sequence. ***Advanced Placement Consideration:** Each fall, 10 seats are allocated to students who meet advanced placement criteria by establishing and maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher. These 10 seats are held until the end of the spring semester to allow advanced standing students to qualify in just two semesters.

Second Degree Accelerated Program: If you have a BS degree in another field, you might want to consider the 3 semester professional sequence. Students must meet Core Curriculum Health Sciences and Science course

requirements as pre-requisites for this track. NOTE: **Applications are accepted between August 1 and August 15 for the January start each year.** Please contact the program coordinator or visit the School of Nursing website for more information.
