ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- RN to BSN: To be admitted into this program, you must have:
 - A Michigan R.N. licensure
 - Cumulative 2.0 GPA
 - "C" or better in each Biology and Chemistry class
- Prior to the final nursing course, you will need to:
 - Earn and maintain current CPR and Emergency Cardiac Care Card
 - Carry health insurance
 - Submit proof of a negative TB test or chest x-ray
 - Receive Hepatitis B vaccine or sign waiver

- Call 1-800-591-3813 (University Center for Extended Learning) to request an application.

- Classroom options include off-campus sites, distance learning, and web-enhanced course work.
- The program is fully accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Committee (NLNAC).
