**ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS**

Admission to Pre-Criminal Justice requires a 2.00 and students can begin the program any semester.

Admission to the Law Enforcement track of Criminal Justice requires a minimum 2.5 college grade point average and total completion of the Pre-Criminal Justice courses. It has a fall entry and could be competitive based on grade point average.

Admission to the Corrections and Generalist tracks of Criminal Justice requires a 2.00 grade point average and completion of the Pre-Criminal Justice courses. Fall entry is preferred.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE**

Transfer students must be admitted (apply & be accepted) 21 days prior to the first day of the semester they plan to attend.

**TRANSFER PLAN**

Transfer of credit is awarded on a course-by-course basis.

Transferable courses are those with grades of "C" (2.00 on a 4.00 scale) or better.
