1. To be admitted to the program, students must have 56 transferable semester credit hours, and a minimum 2.0 gpa.
2. Students must meet the University General Education requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree delineated on the Ferris General Education website.
3. Students must also meet the General Education requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration, which are outlined on the checksheet shown.
4. At least 30 FSU semester hours must be completed from Ferris State University.
5. A minimum of 40 credits must be at the 300/400 level.
6. To graduate from this program, students must have an associate's degree or Ontario college diploma with at least 24 semester credit hours of occupational specialty courses as shown on the second page of this document.
7. A minimum of 124 semester hours must be completed for graduation.
8. To graduate, students must have a 2.0 CUMULATIVE GPA, a 2.0 GPA in the Business Core and a 2.0 in the Major courses. (Students must have a "C" or better in all transfer courses.)
