

ARTICULATION STATEMENT
between
Ferris State University
and
Saginaw Chippewa Tribal College

Saginaw Chippewa Tribal College and Ferris State University have reached certain mutual understandings, which will enable them to better serve their students and prepare those students for high skill, high demand, and high wage jobs.

To that end, the parties have signed this Articulation Statement, setting forth their mutual understandings as follows:

1. The parties will endeavor to provide admittance to Ferris State University at the junior level for students from Saginaw Chippewa Tribal College who meet eligibility requirements including, but not limited to, an associate degree awarded by Saginaw Chippewa Tribal College with at least a 2.00 GPA. In addition, the parties understand that acceptance of Saginaw Chippewa Tribal College student into a specific Ferris State University program will be based on the individual student meeting the conditions and considerations applicable to the specific program.
2. Representatives of both institutions agree to meet on a regular basis to assess curricular changes and other conditions that may affect the nature of this Articulation Statement.
3. The parties will endeavor to make available to Saginaw Chippewa Tribal College students, as mutually agreed upon, appropriate publications and promotional materials regarding this Articulation Statement.
4. This Articulation Statement shall not preclude either institution from making a curriculum change if deemed appropriate by the institution making the change.
5. Beginning two years after it is executed this Articulation Statement may be unilaterally dissolved by either institution upon 180 days' written notice to the other, or it may be dissolved at any time upon mutual agreement of both institutions.
