Admission Requirements to Ferris:

1. Minimum credits for admission to the degree program require at least 48 transferable credits from Macomb or a completed Associate Degree. Credits and/or degree must be in Automotive Technology, Comprehensive Automotive Training certificate, or equivalent.
2. To be considered for financial aid from Ferris, students must take at least six credit hours each semester. Students may be concurrently enrolled at both Ferris and Macomb.
3. A 2.3 overall GPA is required for admission, and the completion of Macomb CC MATH 0070 (or equivalent from another college) with a C or better prior to application. Official college transcripts must be submitted at time of application for admission.
4. Students are encouraged to complete the equivalent of FSU ENGL150 and ENGL250 or ENGL211 prior to admissions, however students are required to complete at least one English course with a C or better prior to being admitted into the program (Ferris ENGL150 or MCC ENGL1180 or ENGL1210 or its equivalent from another accredited institution). Prior to graduation students must complete all general education classes listed on page two.

Graduation Requirements:

1. To graduate, students must have a 2.0 Cumulative GPA in all FSU courses.
2. At least 30 FSU semester hours must be completed to fulfill FSU residency requirements.
3. At least 40 credits must be completed at the 300 level or higher.
4. Students must meet ALL of the University General Education hours requirements listed on page two.
5. Students must have completed an associate degree in Automotive Technology or related area.
6. 123-126 credit hours are required for graduation.

Students are strongly encouraged to meet with an advisor early in their program, to ensure appropriate classes are selected to meet all graduation requirements.

Automotive Management Requirements

Students must also complete a minimum of 42 credits in AUTO classes (or equivalent) from Macomb Community College.
