3. At least 30 FSU semester hours must be completed to fulfill FSU residency requirements.
4. A minimum of 120 semester hours must be completed for graduation – 40 of which must be 300 level or higher.
5. Students must meet the University General Education Hours requirements listed on the reverse side.
