Notes:

- Students must have an Associates in an Allied Health Professional Program (radiography, respiratory, dental hygiene, health information management, medical assisting, mental health, nuclear medicine, practical nursing, surgical technology) for admission into the program.
- A 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admission into the program.
- A 2.00 cumulative GPA is required in the major and overall for graduation from the Allied Health program.
- A minimum of 30 credits must be FSU credits and a minimum of 122 credits total.
- Students must meet FSU General Education requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree delineated on the FSU General Education website. This includes taking one global consciousness and one race/ethnicity/gender course. Learn more about general education courses at: <http://www.ferris.edu/htmls/academics/gened/courses.html>
- A "C" or better grade must be earned to allow for course transfer to FSU.
- Students must earn 40 credit hours at the 300/400 level to graduate.**

- Degree completion requires 122 semester hours (50 semester hours from Professional Associates) and as CSCC is on the quarter system, this differential has been calculated into the numbers above.
