**Notes:**

- Students must have an Associates in Dental Hygiene and valid RDH or LDH license for admission into the program.
- A 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admission into the program.
- A 2.00 cumulative GPA is required in the major and overall for graduation from the Dental Hygiene program.
- A minimum of 30 credits must be FSU credits and a minimum of 122 credits total.
- Students must meet FSU General Education requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree delineated on the FSU General Education website. This includes taking one global consciousness and one race/ethnicity/gender course. Learn more about general education courses at: <http://www.ferris.edu/htmls/academics/gened/courses.html>
- A "C" or better grade must be earned to allow for course transfer to FSU.
- Students must earn 40 credit hours at the 300/400 level to graduate.

- Degree completion requires 122 semester hours (40 semester hours from Dental Hygiene) and as CSCC is on the quarter system, this differential has been calculated into the numbers above.
- Though it is possible to complete the DHYG sequence of classes in 1 year with prior approval from the Department at Ferris, it is recommended that the DHYG sequence of classes be spread over more than 2 semesters.
