Application Deadlines:

1. Transfer students must be admitted 21 days prior to the first day of the semester they plan to attend.

Admission Requirements:

1. Transfer students with 29 credit hours or less must possess a high school grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) and an ACT composite score of 17.
2. Transfer students with 30 credit hours or more must possess a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
3. Students must complete MACRAO and have the MACRAO Stamp on their transcripts, or they will be required to complete the Ferris General Education requirements with a 2.0 cumulative GPA. Graduation Requirements:

1. Graduation requires a minimum 2.5 GPA in the curriculum and a minimum 2.25 GPA overall.
2. 30 minimum FSU semester hours must be completed to fulfill FSU residency requirements.
3. A minimum of 120 credit hours are required for graduation.
