Notes:

- Students must have an Associates in Dental Hygiene and valid RDH or LDH license for admission into the program.
- A 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admission into the program.
- A 2.00 cumulative GPA is required in the major and overall for graduation from the Dental Hygiene program.
- A minimum of 30 credits must be FSU credits and a minimum of 128 credits total.
- Students must meet FSU General Education requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree delineated on the FSU General Education website. This includes taking one global consciousness and one race/ethnicity/gender course. Learn more about general education courses at:
