Notes:

- Students must have an Associates in Dental Hygiene and valid RDH or LDH license for admission into the program.
- A 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admission into the program.
- A 2.00 cumulative GPA is required in the major and overall for graduation from the Dental Hygiene program.
- A minimum of 30 credits must be FSU credits and a minimum of 122 credits total.
- Students must meet FSU General Education requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree delineated on the FSU General Education website. - A "C" or better grade must be earned to allow for course transfer to FSU.
- Students must earn 40 credit hours at the 300/400 level to graduate.
