Notes:

1. A 2.7 cumulative GPA is required for admission into the program.
2. A 2.00 cumulative GPA is required in the major and overall for graduation from the Respiratory Care program.
3. A minimum of 15 credits must be FSU credits and a minimum of 82 credits total.
4. Students must meet FSU General Education requirements for an Associates of Applied Science degree delineated on the FSU General Education website, if the student does NOT get the MACRAO stamp. 5. FSU honors the MACRAO stamp on an official transcript as fulfilling lower level general education courses that **are not** programmatic or prerequisite requirements.
6. A "C" or better grade must be earned to allow for course transfer to FSU.
7. To determine how courses will transfer into Ferris, check the transfer equivalency grid: <http://www.ferris.edu/admissions/Transfer/WebPages/homepage1.cfm>
8. A grade of a B- or better (in two attempts) must be earned in MATH 110, CHEM 103, BIOL 109, with a grade of a C or better earned in MRIS 102 & ENGL 150. These courses must be completed prior to applying for admission into the professional sequence (RESP courses). 9. All science and math courses must be taken within 5 years of application to your professional sequence.
