Admission Requirements to AAS in Radiography

1. To be eligible for admission, students must have earned a minimum of a 2.5 grade point average either from high school or through completion of other college work. Official high school or college transcripts must be submitted at the time of application for admission.
2. Minimum grade of C in MATH 100 or equivalent or Math ACT subscore of 19 or higher
3. Minimum Science Reasoning ACT subscore of 21 or higher
4. Minimum grade of C in BIOL 105 or BIOL 202

Graduation Requirements:

1. To graduate from the Radiography program, students must earn a "C" grade or better in each of the RADI, and Core courses in addition to BIOL 109.
2. A minimum of 89 semester hours must be completed to earn this associate of applied science degree.
3. Students must meet the General Education requirements listed on the reverse side.
