Application Deadlines:

1. Transfer students must be admitted 21 days prior to the first day of the semester they plan to attend.

Admission Requirements:

1. Transfer students with 30 cr. hrs. or more completed must have a minimum 2.0 overall GPA (on 4.0 scale)
2. Students may complete MACRAO and have the MACRAO Stamp on their transcripts OR are required to complete the Ferris General Education requirements with a 2.0 cumulative GPA. To view the Ferris General Education requirements, go to: <http://www.ferris.edu/HTMLS/academics/gened/gened.html>

Graduation Requirements:

1. To graduate, students must have a 2.5 GPA in the curriculum and a minimum 2.25 cumulative GPA
2. At least 30 FSU semester hours must be completed to fulfill Ferris residency requirements
3. A minimum of 40 cr. hrs. must be completed at the 300-level or higher
4. All general education requirements must be met
3. A minimum of 120 semester hours must be completed for graduation.
