Eligibility Criteria:

- Be admitted to a degree granting program with a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- Be a Michigan Resident and a member of the Michigan National Guard.
- Be eligible for the Reserve Benefits under the Montgomery GI Bill.
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress at Ferris State University.
- Must submit a current year Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and complete all requested requirements in order to receive a FSU Financial Aid Award Notice.

How to Apply:

- Apply for admission to a degree granting program at Ferris State University.
- Complete the attached FSU Michigan National Guard Tuition Grant Application to apply for funds for Fall and/or Spring semesters.
- Submit a current year Federal Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) and complete all requested requirements in order to receive a FSU Financial Aid Award Notice.
- Have a Michigan National Guard representative verify on the application form that you are a member of the Michigan National Guard and qualify for Reserve Benefits under the Montgomery GI Bill.

Please note: This application must be submitted for each term you are requesting the grant.
