**After registering for your classes -**

**Check Your Account:** Verify that your financial aid is complete at the Timme Center for Student Services.

**Ferris Student ID:** If you didn't get your student ID picture taken during the check-in procedure, please return to the Timme Center for Student Services. If you will be living on campus this fall, you'll receive your ID when you check into your residence hall in August. If you will be living off campus or in family housing, your ID will be available at the Timme Center for Student Services starting August 31, 2009

**Student Employment:** The majority of on-campus job opportunities posted on the Student Employment web-site begin on August 1, 2009. Log onto <http://www.ferris.edu>, click on the "current student" link, and choose Student Employment located on the left hand side.

**Public Safety:** If you plan on bringing a vehicle with you this fall, you'll need to register it with Public Safety. Please register your vehicle at the Public Safety Office, West Commons Building, 1319 Cramer Circle, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

**Tour:** We will offer a variety of campus tours daily. Final details will be available during Orientation.

**Lundberg Bookstore – Rankin Center:** Visit the Lundberg Bookstore to pre-order your books for Fall semester. After registering for your classes, bring your schedule and the book reservation form from the Orientation information packet you received during check in to the Lundberg Bookstore in Rankin Center. They'll have the books waiting for you when you return for Fall classes, beginning August 31, 2009.

**Huntington Bank:** If you missed this during the check-in process and wish to establish an account with Huntington, you should visit the downtown branch of Huntington Bank when you return to campus in the fall. You will need to have your student ID with you when setting up the account so you can enjoy all of the benefits offered to Ferris students from Huntington Bank. Huntington Bank is located at 301 S. State Street in Big Rapids, approximately 4 blocks north of the University.

**Optional CLEP Testing:** CLEP examinations are available by appointment through the Institutional Research & Testing, Timme CCS, Room 313. Individuals desiring to take CLEP examinations must schedule a testing appointment.
