Scholarships and Awards

The purpose of financial aid is to supplement students and their family's contributions toward the cost of education, as well as to recognize academic achievement and special talents. Ferris State University offers a variety of scholarships, grants, loans, and part-time employment to assist students in financing their education. The office of scholarships and financial aid is responsible for the processing and disbursement of all types of federal, state, private, and institutional (university) funds to students. Decisions are made by, or in consultation with, that office unless otherwise specifically stated in the full text document.

Federal Requirements

The requirements necessary to participate in any of the federal financial aid programs are:

1. Enrollment in a degree-granting program;
2. Enrollment status must be at least half-time. For a few specific programs, full-time attendance is necessary;
3. Citizenship or a permanent resident alien;
4. Must be making academic progress;
5. Not be in default on a previously received student loan.

Application Procedures

Students should complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and then carefully review the Student Aid Report (SAR) which is received as a result of filing the FAFSA. New students may obtain a FAFSA from their high school guidance office or from a college financial aid office. Continuing Ferris students will receive a renewal application in the mail, or they can pick up the FAFSA in the office of scholarships and financial aid, 102 Prakken. Students may expedite the financial aid application process by submitting their application electronically. Using FAFSA on the Web will shorten the application time from six weeks to ten days. The FAFSA on the web address is www.fafsa.ed.gov. The form can also be accessed through Ferris State University's financial aid web page.

The student will receive a Student Aid Report (SAR), which should be read carefully for accuracy. The office of scholarships and financial aid will have received the data electronically as long as Ferris State University was included on the financial aid application.

Some students are required to verify the information by submitting tax forms for themselves and their parents. Tax forms should not be submitted unless requested by the Ferris office of scholarships and financial aid.

Transfer students should request that a financial aid transcript be sent to Ferris from all colleges previously attended whether or not financial aid was received.

Priority consideration is given to files that are completed by March 15 of the upcoming award year. Files completed after that date are considered based on funds available.

Keep the office of scholarships and financial aid aware of changes in address or financial status.

Student Employment

There are two types of employment available to students who wish to earn part of the cost of their education: (1) need based or (2) non-need based employment. Though the jobs available to students through these programs are very similar, there are some basic differences between the two.

Need-Based Employment

Need-based employment is divided into three types: Federal work/study, Michigan work/study and Ferris employment awards. In all cases, the student is provided the opportunity to earn part of the cost of his/her education by working on campus. The office of scholarships and financial aid assigns the amount to be earned. The Ferris student employment office places the student in a job after considering the amount awarded and the student's schedule of classes. A limited number of jobs are also available off-campus through Federal Work-Study Community Service.

Non Need-Based Employment

Ferris also offers a substantial number of jobs on campus that are open to all students, whether they are receiving financial aid or not. The student employment office assists students in securing these positions. The student is paid twice a month, usually at the current minimum wage. The student must abide by the working regulations put forth by the employing department. If the job is to be terminated, the student must notify the employing department and the student employment office immediately.
