UNDERGRADUATE ACADEMIC PROBATION/ACADEMIC PROBATION WARNING February 3, 2009

ACADEMIC PROBATION:

A student is placed on probation if his or her cumulative GPA falls below a 2.0. This status is determined once grade calculations are processed after exam week. The student will remain on probation until the cumulative GPA increase to a 2.0 GPA or above. After two consecutive semesters of probation, a student may be academically dismissed. Any student who is on academic probation cannot enroll for more than 14 credit hours without receiving permission from his or her advisor.

The temporary grade of "I" will not prevent a student from being placed on probation.
Grades of "I" are not figured into the GPA.

SEMESTER ACADEMIC ADVISORY NOTICE:

A student will receive a Semester Academic Advisory Notice if his or her current semester GPA falls below a 2.0. This status is determined once grade calculations are processed after exam week. The student will receive a Semester Academic Advisory Notice each semester that his or her current semester GPA falls below a 2.0.

Any student who receives a Semester Academic Advisory Notice cannot enroll for more than 14 credit hours without receiving permission from his or her advisor.

The temporary grade of "I" will not prevent a student from being placed on probation.
Grades of "I" are not figured into the GPA.
