Your college mentor is willing to assist faculty and staff who are developing proposals upon request. It is not anticipated they will do the bulk of the work for the grant planning or writing unless they are part of the project. The College Grant Mentor will simply serve as an experienced colleague who has been through the process and can offer support, review, evaluation and support with respect to your written proposal as it responds to a formal solicitation, if there is one.
