Athletic Advisory Committee

The Athletic Advisory Committee had a difficult time this year in having members attend meetings and thus having a quorum. We did not have quorums at either our January or February meeting leading me to conduct our business via email. As such, our accomplishments this year were rather minimal. We drafted a notice that I brought before the Senate in April asking to have athletic coaches notified if a student-athlete was struggling in a class. This motion was defeated by the Senate, although they did give some good feedback to the chair. Due to our lack of meetings, this was the only business that went forward. An additional task we continue to work on is updating the coach CV booklets we developed a few years ago for distribution to the academic department heads.

Some goals for next year are to have a membership that is interested in meeting. For most of the meetings, a core group did show up, but there were a few members who never indicated their absence in advance. Additional goals would be to continue to update the coach CV booklets and to make sure a dialogue does exist between the coaches and the faculty. We likely need to increase awareness of the committee's role as well; I plan to meet with the Athletic Director over the summer to work on this.
