Main accomplishments for 2003-04

1. Continued past practice of supporting the “Great American Smoke Out” day during fall semester. Next year may add “Smoke Out” day to winter semester.
2. Formulated a mission statement for committee.
3. Revised committee name from “Substance Abuse Committee” to “Substance Abuse and Health Promotion Committee” to be more reflective of our mission statement.
4. We will be creating a Substance Abuse and Health Promotion presentation about Social Norming. This presentation will be given during a Faculty Professional Development session during fall kick off week. A modification of the presentation will be developed and be available to FSUS 100 classes. We will explore the possibility of senior level Psychology students being trained to do the FSUS 100 presentations.
5. A pamphlet will be distributed at Presidents Fall Kick-off and/or Faculty Luncheon about our committee and Social Norming.
6. We have begun working on a long range goal of developing a website link from the main Ferris site which would include links to: Social Norming Resource Center, Free Alcohol Screening, Curriculum Infusion Ideas with useful teaching materials, Eating Disorders Screening, and the Great American Smoke Out.
