**NEW BUSINESS:**

Cindy Horn was present to give an update on the Student Recreation Center's fitness. Highlights of her talk:

- She's working with Dr. Cairns to find some money for replacement of machines
- Center has no replacement budget for equipment, have to replace equipment from operational budget
- Evaluated equipment recently and have a plan to replace equipment
  - 15 pieces of cardio equipment over 13 years old. Lifecycle is 5 years; 15 other pieces of equipment are beyond repair and reside in a "graveyard" of sorts in the center
  - Plan from one company is around \$78,000 and will be 38 pieces of equipment including recumbent bikes, regular bikes, spinning bikes and stair master type machines. Maintenance plan to keep equipment in working order included.
  - This is one plan of a possible 2 or 3 that the center needs. These machines will appear on campus soon, depending on approval from Dr. Cairns. He says this is a top priority.
- Rec Center will order new weights from current funds at around \$2,000. This will happen soon
- Pool built in the late 50's. Mechanicals are very old and unreliable. Pool will be repaired in the summer and will be closed most of the summer for this repair.
- Intramurals coordinator hired in December. Full schedule of sports on the docket for the Spring

- IM Fees are in line with other universities and were recently changed to a per participant fee rather than per team. This helps keep costs spread out more evenly
- 7,000 students participated last year
- IM Fees purchase many supplies such as footballs, flag belts and help pay officials ([Probably underpaid, Editorial content from secretary](#))
- Over 200,000 patrons used the facility last year
- Operational budget of \$400,000; student staff budget is \$179,000 and has remained steady for many years
- Hire about 100-200 students annually
- Need about 6 staff for every hour facility open
