- The committee is required to send a report, with its various recommendations, to the Academic Senate in April.
- After agreeing that a member previously serving on the committee should act as chair, the committee selected Doug Haneline.
- Sharon Bell will arrange for meeting space at the College of Business Building.
- Two student representatives appointed by Student Government are technically supposed to comprise part of the committee, yet historically student members have rarely attended committee meetings. Keith Jewett volunteered to contact Student Government in order to encourage student participation in the committee.
- Five areas were selected as the focus for committee activity in the upcoming year: Judicial Services, Counseling Center, University College, Campus Pipeline, and International Affairs.
- Doug Haneline will supply the committee with supporting documentation on previous committee involvement with the five areas and will arrange for representatives of the areas to address the committee on the various issues associated with each.
