Significant Accomplishments

As you can see by the attached report which provides an overview of all proposals acted on by the University Curriculum Committee since September 2008, this has been another busy year. Among the 87 proposals considered by the UCC to date, 13 required action by the Senate. The one proposal still pending will also require Senate action at a later date. Once completed, there will have been four new degree programs, three significant program re-directions, three new minors, two new certificates, one new concentration, and one program elimination..

Should the Senate choose to adopt a proposal on the agenda for the April 28 meeting to make revisions to the Form A, the Curriculum Planning and Procedures Manual will need to be updated to reflect those changes.

Future Challenges

As we continue to prepare for the upcoming accreditation visit by members of the Higher Learning Commission, the UCC has been vigilant in insisting that all new courses, as well as those being modified, now include detailed outcomes and assessment information. An efficient process to expedite the addition of outcomes and assessment information for all courses, certificates, and programs currently on the system will need to be implemented during the coming 2009-2010 and the precise role UCC will need to play in that process will have to be carefully considered.
