Make it clear on the checksheet and sequence sheet how and when a student completes a particular option. Identify (or create anew?) a department for newly created courses. Address concerns raised by Nagelkirk concerning physical limitations for offering FMAN 321 and HVAC 483. Course descriptions on pages 30 and 31 must be limited to 75 words, and clarify final sentence on page 32. Page 33, clarify intentions on Ilm & n (white out EEET 433??). Revise program outcomes (removing those gen ed outcomes), state in measurable terms, and include them on the Form D (curriculum checksheet.)
