Suggest proposers work with Lang and Lit address the issue. Due to recent changes in MGMT 302, Leonard will clarify with Anita Fagerman whether it is still their intention to remove the course from their program. The change cannot go into effect until Fall 2010, due to having already missed the deadline for Fall '09 catalogue changes.
New Minor	Minor in Construction	Sent back.	Due to having already missed the deadline for Fall '09 catalogue changes, this new minor cannot go into effect until Fall 2010. Form A, item 2d needs to be completed. Request a clearer statement of outcomes and assessment information. Concern was raised about the “hidden prerequisites” effectively making the minor 23 credits. Shouldn't CONM 111 and CONM 116 be identified as part of the minor?

- VI. Andy shared a presentation he'll be making to the Senate that illustrate UCC's efforts this year to become increasingly more paperless.
- VII. Proposed Form A Revisions were discussed. The committee supported the proposal to add a list of consultations to the Form A, but questioned the need to include "date received" as opposed simply "date sent." External accreditation falls more closely within the domain of the APRC. The committee questioned the need for including a checkbox on the Form A, unless it would automatically alert APRC. Andy noted that the PCAF already has a place where it is indicated.
