New Degree	Nuclear Medicine Technology	Sent back.	Due to the major changes and new courses, please submit a PCAF. On Form A, first paragraph, clarify in greater detail how you intend to transition students from the AAS to the BS. Check on status of all Form B's (sent back in April), and send one to Lang & Lit. On Proposed Form D, create separate checkbox for Race, Ethnicity, and Gender and Global Awareness as these requirements may also be met with courses other than Social Awareness. Also on Form D, clarify how "computer competency" is to be met. Form F's: Do you really intend to always offer all courses every term (as indicated by current Forms)? Numbers on course titles cannot be Roman Numerals. Change to Arabic numbers. The following proposed course modifications are so significant that you should delete the old course and then add a new course in its place: NUCM 140 to 240, NUCM 350 to 440, and NUCM 291 to 491, and NUCM 292 to 492. (Then double check the other Form F's to ensure the pre-req. and co-req. information is correct). On NUCM 100 and 101, you can if you choose, list the major code under pre-req to make it a true as opposed to just a comment. Please include a semester-by-semester plan. Add student learning outcomes to Form D's and include an assessment plan for the degree.
