What is a Banner Index?

The Index, although not part of the FOAPAL, plays a large role in data entry. Consider an index as a convenience tool, replacing the need to enter the entire FOAPAL string, generally, with the exception of account.

- G = General Fund
- D = Designated Fund
- E = Expendable Restricted Fund
- X = Auxiliary Fund
- L = Loan Fund
- I = Investment Fund
- A = Agency Fund
- P = Plant Fund
- V = Voc Ed Funds
- M = Maintenance & Repair Funds
