

INVITATION TO SELF-IDENTIFY FOR VETERANS

You are invited to voluntarily identify your status as a Special Disabled Veteran, a Vietnam Era Veteran, or a Veteran who has served on active duty during a war or in a campaign, or expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized. This information will be kept confidential.

Disclosing or refusing to disclose this information will not subject you to any adverse treatment. The information will be used only in accordance with the regulations promulgated under 38 USC 2012. Please select an appropriate category.

- Special Disabled Veteran: A veteran who is entitled to disability pay from the Department of Veterans Affairs (or would have been if not receiving retirement pay) or was released or discharged from active duty because of a service-connected disability.

- Vietnam-Era Veteran: A person who: (A) served in the military, ground, naval or air service of the United States on active duty for a period of more than 180 days, and was discharged or released therefrom with other than a dishonorable discharge, if any part of such active duty occurred: (i) in the Republic of Vietnam between February 28, 1961, and May 7, 1975; or (ii) between August 5, 1964, and May 7, 1975, in all other cases; or (B) was discharged or released from active duty for a service-connected disability if any part of such active duty was performed (i) in the Republic of Vietnam between February 28, 1961, and May 7, 1975; or (ii) between August 5, 1964, and May 7, 1975, in all other cases.
