

RESIDENTIAL LIFE POLICY LETTER

TO: All Members of the University Community 2004:02

DATE: October 1, 2004

OVERNIGHT VISITATION PROGRAM

I. The Overnight Visitation Program (OVP) permits one or two overnight guests on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights. Guests are defined as any person not assigned to that room. Guests must be registered at the front desk of the residence hall prior to midnight in order to be eligible. No more than two (2) guests will be permitted at any one time in each room.

II. To register an overnight guest, the host must obtain his/her roommate's consent, and guests must present picture identification. OVP guests must carry the yellow copy of the registration form as confirmation of their registration. All guests and hosts must adhere to the escort policy. Resident hosts are responsible for their registered and unregistered guests. All guests under 18 years of age must have a signed letter of permission from a parent or legal guardian to stay on campus.

III. No overnight guests are permitted Sunday, Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday nights. The University reserves the right to limit frequency of visits or suspend visitation privileges when appropriate to protect the rights of others. The right of a roommate to live in reasonable privacy supercedes the right of a host to have overnight guests.
